




Weekly One Liners 22nd July to 28th July 2019

National Affairs

- Indian Space Research Organisation launched Chandrayaan 2 from Satish Dhawan Space Center at Sriharikota. It was launched by GSLV MkIII-M1 Vehicle at 14:43 hours IST. The lander-Vikram will land near South Pole of the moon on Sep 7, 2019. Chandrayaan 2 is India's 2nd moon mission.
- Government of India will provide 10,000 scholarships for heirs of the liberation war fighters of Bangladesh called 'Muktijodhas' over the next five years under the Nutan India-Bangladesh Maitree Muktijodha Sontan Scholarship Scheme.
- A new India-UK bilateral pilot scheme, the UKEIRI Mobility Programme: Study in India was launched by Universities UK International (UUKi) and British Council India. It aims to generate up to 200 opportunities for undergraduate students at UK universities to visit India by March 2021.
- The government has set a target for the installation of Rooftop Solar projects of 40,000 MegaWatt by 2022 in the country.
- GoI has reconstituted the Group of Ministers (GoM) looking after the issues of how to prevent sexual harassment at workplace and strengthen legal frameworks. The GoM will be lead by Home Minister Amit Shah. The other members of the reconstituted GoM are: Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, HRD Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank', and Women and Child Development Minister Smriti Irani.
- The Digital Communications Commission (DCC) approved the cumulative penalty of Rs 3,050 crore on Bharti Airtel and Vodafone Idea.
- Asian Development Bank has sanctioned Rs 1925 Cr project for up-gradation of power generation and distribution in Tripura for upgrading capacity of Rokhia Project and Gumti Hydro Electric Project.



- The Western Railway General Stores Depot (GSD) has become the first in Indian Railways to opened a heritage gallery of the printing and allied machines.
- Kaiga Atomic Energy station (Karnataka) sets a World Record in continuous operation of 962 days by Unit-1 of Kaiga Generating Station (KGS-1).
- Kargil veteran Lt Col Dr Samir Rawat has been invited as an eminent keynote speaker at the 32nd International Congress of Psychology 2020 (ICP) in Prague.

States in the News

- Raksha Mantri inaugurated the 1 kilometre long Ujh bridge in Kathua district and 617.40 Metre long Basantarbridge in Samba district of Jammu &Kashmir. 1 Km long Ujh bridge is the longest bridge constructed by Border Roads Organisation(BRO).
- Telangana Government and the World Economic Forum's Centre for the 4th Industrial Revolution Network announced that they are set to launch an innovative project to deliver emergency medical supplies such as blood and vaccines via drones. This pilot project, called Medicine from the Sky, will run in partnership with the State Government and HealthNet Global Limited.
- The number of districts in Tamil Nadu will go up to 35 as the government has carve out Tenkasi district from Tirunelveli district and Chengalpet district from Kancheepuram district.
- Researchers discovered Dracaena cambodiana, a dragon-tree species which has been reported for the first time in India, in the Dongka Sarpo area of West Karbi Anglong district in Assam.
- Chief Minister of odisha Naveen Patnaik has launched the revamped website of Odisha Tourism, odishatourism.gov.in. for promoting state brands Boyanika and Utkalika.
- Gujarat ranks on top in the installation of rooftop solar projects with an installed capacity of 261.97 megawatts.
- Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh launched the statewide tree plantation programme 'Clean-Green Arunachal Campaign 2019' in Itanagar.

International Affairs

- U.S. space agency NASA prepares to send "first woman and next man" on Moon as part of its ambitious Artemis programme in 2024.
- Andhra Pradesh has become the first state in the country to reserve 75% private jobs for locals. The Andhra Pradesh Assembly passed the Andhra Pradesh Employment of Local Candidates in Industries/Factories Act, 2019.




- Scientists in Bangladesh have developed a method to convert Jute fibre into low cost bio-degradable cellulose sheets named "Sonali".
- The Non Aligned movement ministerial meeting was held in Caracas, Venezuela. India's Permanent Representative to the UN Ambassador Syed Akbaruddin represented India in the meeting.
- Beijing-based startup "Interstellar Glory Space Technology" also known as iSpace successfully launched the china's first commercial rocket.
- **Pakistan** announced that it will send its **first astronaut** to space in **2022**. It will be using close ally China's satellite launching facilities to execute the mission.

- Life Insurance Corporation of India has agreed to offer Rs 1.25 trillion Line of Credit by 2024, to fund highway projects under Bharatmala project.

- National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) and JCB International have launched RuPay JCB Global Cards.

- The **Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI)** has announced that Bengaluru-based education and learning **app Byju's**, as the official Team India sponsor.

- PM Narendra Modi releases book "Chandra Shekhar -The Last Icon of Ideological Politics" is written by Deputy Chairman in the Rajya Sabha, Harivansh and Ravi Dutt Bajpai.

- "Inter-Ministerial Committee" on legality of cryptocurrencies and blockchain has submitted its report to the Finance Ministry. The committee was set up under the Chairmanship of Economic Affairs Secretary Subhash Chandra Garg in 2017.
- Reserve Bank of India has assigned deputy governor B.P. Kanungo to run the monetary policy portfolio and forecasting department. After the exit of Viral Acharya, Kanungo has become the 6th member of the RBI's Monetary Policy Committee.
- The International Monetary Fund has lowered its annual growth forecast for India from 7.3% to 7% in financial year 2019-20.
- Apple has announced the acquisition of chip-maker Intel's smartphone modem business for \$1 billion.

- Boris Johnson will replace Theresa May as Britain's next Prime Minister.
- Lalji Tandon will replace Anandiben Patel as governor of Madhya Pradesh.
- Anandiben Patel will replace Ram Naik as governor of Uttar Pradesh.
- Jagdeep Dhankhar will replace Keshari Nath Tripathi as governor of West Bengal.
- Phagu Chuhan will replace Lalji Tandon as governor of Bihar.
- R.N. Ravi will replace P.B. Acharya as governor of Nagaland.
- Ramesh Bais will replace Kaptan Singh Solanki as governor of Tripura.
- Lieutenant-General M.M. Naravane, has been appointed as the next Vice-Chief of the Army Staff. He will replace Lt. Gen. D. Anbu. He is currently serving as General Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Army Command.
- Pakistan Cricket Board's chairman Ehsan Mani has been appointed as the head of the ICC's influential Finance and Commercial Affairs committee.
- The U.S. Senate confirmed former soldier Mark Esper as Secretary of Defence, filling America's longest-ever Pentagon leadership vacuum as Washington faces mounting tensions with Iran.
- The Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) has appointed the Canadian Dejan Papic as the head coach of the Indian table tennis team.
- Priti Patel has been appointed as Britain's Home Secretary in the newly-unveiled Boris Johnson Cabinet and has all become the Britain's first Indian-origin Home Secretary.



- Ajay Kumar Bhalla has been appointed Officer on Special Duty (OSD) to the Ministry of Home Affairs.
- Sunil Kumar has been given additional charge of chairman and managing director of the Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited (MTNL).
- The leader of the Congress party in Lok Sabha, **Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury** was appointed as the **Chairman** of the **Public Accounts Committee (PAC).**

- The Indian Navy commissioned its new Dornier Aircraft Squadron in Chennai. This is Indian Navy's 5th Dornier Aircraft squadron.
- The Indian armed forces are all set to conduct the country's first-ever simulated space warfare exercise "IndSpaceEx".
- Defence Minister launched dashboard of Department Defence Production (DDP), Ministry of Defence to keep track of the major components of Defence Production, including defence exports, defence offsets, Intellectual Property Rights and Mission Raksha Gyan Shakti.
- The Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) launched an online encyclopedia called Securitypedia and also launched customised video interface for its personnel called CISFTube.

- The Britain swimmer Adam Peaty has break the world record in the men's 100 metre breaststroke at the World Championships in Gwangju, South Korea. He smashed the previous record of 57.10 seconds that was set by him at last year's European Championships, after winning the semi finals in 56.88 seconds.
- Indian sprinter **Hima Das** extended her sensational run by claiming her **fifth gold** of the month as she returned to her pet **400m competition** with a season-best time of 52.09 seconds in Nove Mesto, **Czech Republic**.
- Shiva Thapa became India's first gold-medallist in the newly-introduced Olympic category of 63kg at the President's Cup boxing tournament after getting a walkover in the finals in Astana, Kazakhstan.
- Indian bodybuilder Ravinder Kumar Malik has clinched Mr. South Asia title. He has crowned the overall champion at 12th South Asian Bodybuilding and Physique Sports Championship in Kathmandu.
- Shooting Junior World Cup, Aishwarya Pratap Singh Tomar clinched gold with a junior world record in the final of rifle 3-position event in Suhl Germany.
- Japan's Akane Yamaguchi wins Indonesia Open BWF Tour Super 1000 tournament held in Jakarta, Indonesia. She defeated India's P.V. Sindhu in the title clash by 21-15, 21-16

- Tunisia's President Beji Caid Essebsi, the first democratically elected leader of the North African country passed away. He was the world's oldest sitting president.


