S1. Ans.(b)

Sol. 'Focus' is the correct fit for the blank here.

S2. Ans.(a)

Sol. 'Pumped' is the correct fit for the blank here.

S3. Ans.(d)

Sol. 'Differentiated' is the correct fit for the blank here and it means recognize or ascertain what makes (someone or something) different.

S4. Ans.(b)

Sol. 'Proportions' is the correct fit for the blank here.

S5. Ans.(c)

Sol. 'Raising' is the correct fit for the blank here.

S6. Ans.(b)

Sol. 'Grossly' is the correct fit for the blank here and it means in a very obvious and unacceptable manner; flagrantly.

S12. Ans.(a)

Sol. Error is in option (a). It should be 'no' instead of 'not'.

S13. Ans.(b)

Sol. 'Contributed' is the correct fit for the blank here.

S14. Ans.(c)

Sol. Option (c) is correct here. Refer paragraph 3 of the above passage: " Summer winds in India are driven by the temperature contrast between the Indian subcontinent ".

S15. Ans.(d)

Sol. 'Accretive' is similar in meaning to 'cumulative'. 'Accretive' means produced by a series of additions of identical or similar things.

S16. Ans.(b)

Sol. 'Contrast' is opposite in meaning to 'correlate'.

S17. Ans.(a)

Sol. 'Beneficial' is the correct fit for the blank here.

S18. Ans.(a)

Sol. 'could well be a defining moment' is the correct fit for the blank and makes the sentence meaningfully correct. Since 'defining' starts with a consonant, it will follow the article 'a'.

S19. Ans.(b)

Sol. 'in any democracy is set up' is the correct fit for the blank and makes the sentence meaningfully correct.

S20. Ans.(d)

Sol. 'it must be done carefully.' is the correct fit for the blank and makes the sentence meaningfully correct.

S21. Ans.(a)

Sol. 'has caught up with the' is the correct fit for the blank and makes the sentence meaningfully correct.

S22. Ans.(c)

Sol. 'suffer from multi-dimensional poverty.' is the correct fit for the blank and makes the sentence meaningfully correct. With 'suffer' we use 'from' in standard English.



S23. Ans.(d)

Sol. 'for the poor appear increasingly dismal.' is the correct fit for the blank and makes the sentence meaningfully correct. Since 'poor' is a proper noun in the context of the sentence, we will use the article 'the' with it.

S24. Ans.(b)

Sol. 'them from falling into it in the' is the correct fit for the blank and makes the sentence meaningfully correct.

S25. Ans.(c)

Sol. 'a boost in their income will provide a' is the correct fit for the blank and makes the sentence meaningfully correct.
