1.FATAL : घातक

Meaning:causing or capable of causing destruction

Synonyms:destructive, fateful

Antonyms:fortunate, assisting

Example:The withdrawal of funds was fatal to the project.

2. ADAPT : अनुकूलन

Meaning: to accommodate oneself to a new condition, setting, or situation

Synonyms:accustom, fit

Antonyms:neglect, refuse

Example:Dogs are known for their ability to quickly adapt to their environments.

3.ADVERSARIAL : विरोधात्मक

Meaning:relating to hostile opposition

Synonyms:opposed, adverse

Antonyms:accepted, favourable

Example:An adversarial attitude will make you many enemies in life.

4.AUSTERE : कठोर

Meaning:stern and forbidding

Synonyms:exacting, rigid

Antonyms:flexible, calm

Example:My boss had an austere expression on her face.

5.COINCIDE : मेल खाना

Meaning:to happen at the same time

Synonyms:concur, correspond

Antonyms:differ, disagree

Example:It wasn't until after I booked my ticket that I realized the concert coincided with my finals.


6.DIRE : भयानक

Meaning:hopeless and dangerous or fearful

Synonyms: serious, drastic

Antonyms:mild, trivial

Example:When the police didn't explain what was happening right away, Jane knew that the situation must be dire.



7.EMPIRICAL : प्रयोगसिद्ध

Meaning:derived from experience, observation, or an experiment

Synonyms:experimental, factual

Antonyms:unproved, theoretic

Example:You need empirical evidence to support your claim.

8.IMPOSITION : आरोपण

Meaning:an unnecessary burden

Synonyms:cheating, hoax

Antonyms:honesty, reality

Example:If it's not too much of an imposition, could you proofread my paper?

9.LUCRATIVE : लाभप्रद

Meaning:capable of making a lot of money

Synonyms:profitable, fruitful

Antonyms:unprofitable

Example:Writing books isn't a particularly lucrative career, unless you're J.K. Rowling.

10.OBSOLETE : पुराने ढंग का

Meaning:no longer used

Synonyms:retired, outdated

Antonyms:new, fresh

Example:Historians assumed record players would be obsolete by now, but in fact they're making a huge comeback.

11. ABET: उकसाना

Meaning: encourage or assist (someone) to do something wrong.

Synonyms: ferment, incite, instigate, encourage.

Antonyms: constrain, curb, inhibit, tame.

Usage: If you abet violence in your home, you should not be surprised if your children grow up to be abusers.

12. INTRANSIGENT : दुराग्रही

Meaning: unwilling or refusing to change one's views or to agree about something.

Synonyms: uncompromising, resolute, inexorable, inveterate.

Antonyms: submissive, tractable, acquiescent, subservient.

Usage: John remained intransigent in restricting his gift to the rescue children.

13. RIPARIAN : तटीय

Meaning: relating to or situated on the banks of a river.

Synonyms: riverine, coastal, continental, seaside.

Antonyms: intercontinental, inland.

Usage: This serious defect of solid weirs, where the riparian lands are liable to be injured by inundations, can be slightly mitigated by keeping down the crest of the weir somewhat below the required level.

14. PROMPTITUDE : सामयिकता

Meaning: the quality or habit of arriving or being ready on time.

Synonyms: alacrity, aptness, readiness, timeliness.

Antonyms: tardiness, unpunctuality, belatedness, slowness.

Usage: Berg had gained the confidence of his superiors by his promptitude and accuracy and had arranged his money matters very satisfactorily.

15. VERBOSITY : शब्दाडंबर

Meaning: the fact or quality of using more words than needed; wordiness.

Synonyms: loquacity, garrulity, volubility, tautology.

Antonyms: brevity, compactness, concision, succinctness.

Usage: As expressions get more complicated the need to reduce the verbosity of type specification gets more compelling.

16. PRISTINE : मूल

Meaning: clean and fresh as if new; spotless.

Synonyms: immaculate, flawless, unmarked, unblemished.

Antonyms: mucky, vandalized, marred, besmirched.

Usage: As curator of the town museum, I keep all of the artifacts in pristine condition.

17. TRICKLE : बूंद-बूंद

Meaning: a small flow of liquid.

Synonyms: ooze, drizzle, sprinkle, dribble.

Antonyms: flood, inundation, deluge, outpouring.

Usage: He felt the tears trickle under his spectacles and hoped they would not be noticed

18. STATUTE: अधिनियम

Meaning: a written law passed by a legislative body.

Synonyms: regulation, enactment, decree, resolution, promulgation.

Antonyms: refrain, unwritten, inflate, forbear.

Usage: The statute prohibits businesses from selling alcohol to minors.

19. PIT : विरोध करना

Meaning: set someone or something in conflict or competition with.

Synonyms: contend, vie, grapple, wrestle.

Antonyms: agree, charge, fuse, calcify.

Usage: I would pit my command staff against any Fortune 500 company.

20. PRECIPITOUS : बहुत ढालू

Meaning: dangerously high or steep.

Synonyms: sheer, steep, plumb, slanted.

Antonyms: gentle, gradual, flat, horizontal.

Usage: Taylor made the precipitous mistake of agreeing to babysit before she checked her schedule.

21. ACRIMONY : रूखापन

Meaning: bitterness or ill feeling.

Synonyms: bitterness, rancour, resentment, ill feeling

Antonyms: goodwill

Example: The acrimony of the dispute has shocked a lot of people.

22. INFINITESIMAL : अतिसूक्ष्म

Meaning: extremely small.

Synonyms: minute, tiny, minuscule, inappreciable

Antonyms: huge

Example: The amounts of radioactivity present were infinitesimal.

23. LURID : भयंकर

Meaning: presented in vividly shocking or sensational terms.

Synonyms: sensational, sensationalist, melodramatic, exaggerated

Antonyms: restrained, discreet

Example: You can read all the lurid details of the affair in today's paper.

24. MALAISE : अस्वस्थता

Meaning: a general feeling of discomfort, illness, or unease whose exact cause is difficult to identify.

Synonyms: unhappiness, restlessness, uneasiness, unease

Antonyms: comfort, well-being

Example: It is a malaise that affects both intellectuals and the masses.

25. OGLE : घूरना

Meaning: stare at in a lecherous manner.

Synonyms: stare, gawk

Antonyms: ignore, neglect

Example: Most women dislike being ogled .

26. PEEVISH : तुनुकमिजाज

Meaning: having or showing an irritable disposition.

Synonyms: irritable, irascible, fractious, fretful, cross, petulant

Antonyms: affable, easy-going

Example: The whole team was peevish after losing the game.

27. QUINTESSENTIAL : सर्वोत्कृष्ट

Meaning: representing the most perfect or typical example of a quality or class.

Synonyms: typical, prototypical, stereotypical, archetypal, classic

Example: Paris, the quintessential city of freedom and discretion, he could lead a double life.

28. SUAVE : सुशील

Meaning: (especially of a man) charming, confident, and elegant.

Synonyms: charming, sophisticated, debonair, urbane

Antonyms: unsophisticated, rude

Example: He was tall and suave, careful in dress, careful in behaviour.

29. TIRADE : निंदा-भाषण

Meaning: a long, angry speech of criticism or accusation.

Synonyms: diatribe, invective, polemic, denunciation, rant

Antonyms: compliment, praise

Example: She launched into a tirade against the policies that ruined her business.

30. VILE : घिनौना

Meaning: extremely unpleasant.

Synonyms: foul, nasty, unpleasant, bad, disagreeable

Antonyms: pleasant

Example: A vile smell assailed my nostrils.

31. YEARN - लालायित होना

Meaning: desire strongly or persistently

Synonyms: crave, desire

Antonyms: abjure, dislike

Example: Despite his great commercial success he still yearns for critical approval.

32. VAGUE- अज्ञात

Meaning: lacking clarity or distinctness

Synonyms: faint, unclear

Antonyms: clear, certain

Example: The patient had complained of vague pains and backache.

33. UNCANNY - अलौकिक

Meaning: surpassing the ordinary or normal

Synonyms: astonishing, exceptional

Antonyms: boring, common

Example: He has an uncanny ability to pick a winner.

34. TENACIOUS - दृढ़

Meaning: stubbornly unyielding

Synonyms: determined, steadfast

Antonyms: afraid, unreliable

Example: There has been tenacious local opposition to the new airport.

35.RHETORICAL - आलंकारिक

Meaning:relating to using language effectively

Synonyms:articulate, vocal

Antonyms:concise

Example:In the end, we have only neutered rhetorical forms to stand as theories, and random design novelties to stand as practice.

36.QUELL - जीतना

Meaning:suppress or crush completely

Synonyms:conquer, crush

Antonyms:lose, release

Example:This latest setback will have done nothing to quell the growing doubts about the future of the club.

37.PIQUE- मनमुटाव

Meaning:a sudden outburst of anger

Synonyms:annoyance, grudge

Antonyms:delight, pleasure

Example:This latest setback will have done nothing to quell the growing doubts about the future of the club.

38.MELANCHOLY - उदासी

Meaning:a constitutional tendency to be gloomy and depressed

Synonyms:gloomy, sorrowful

Antonyms:bright, cheerful

Example:Larry is in a very melancholy mood.

39.LUCID- सुबोध

Meaning:easily understandable

Synonyms:distinct, clear

Antonyms:cloudy, confused

Example:She gave a clear and lucid account of her plans for the company's future.

40.LETHARGIC- निष्क्रिय

Meaning:deficient in alertness or activity

Synonyms:dull, passive

Antonyms:active, alert

Example:I was feeling tired and lethargic.

41. OVERTURE : सन्धि प्रस्ताव

Meaning: an introduction to something more substantial.

Synonyms: prelude, introduction, opening, voluntary.

Antonyms: conclusion, epilogue, aftermath, coda.

Usage: He spent more time with the orchestra, with the overture in the beginning of the show than the whole block of the show.

42 HEFT : वज़न

Meaning: lift or carry (something heavy).

Synonyms: lift, heave, hoist, haul.

Antonyms: lower, drop, fix, dodge.

Usage: Reluctantly, she hefted herself up and picked up the phone.

43. SUPERANNUATED : वयोवृद्ध

Meaning: outdated or obsolete through age or new developments;

Synonyms: anachronistic, antiquated, defunct, obsolete.

Antonyms: modern, modish, newfangled, modernized.

Usage: The information on my website was superannuated and needed updating.

44. STEER : रास्ते पर लाना

Meaning: Guide the movement or course of.

Synonyms: guide, conduct, direct, lead.

Antonyms: abandon, ashore, fuddle, trail.

Usage: I held back a smile at his obvious attempt to steer me back on course.

45. Brickbat: रोड़ा

Meaning: an act or expression showing scorn and usually intended to hurt another's feelings

Synonyms: affront, barb, epithet, indignity.

Antonyms: accolade, commendation, compliment, acclaim.

Usage: The candidates were reduced to hurling brickbats at each other.

46. TREASON: राज-द्रोह

Meaning: the action of betraying someone or something.

Synonyms: betrayal, disloyalty, falsity, treachery.

Antonyms: faithfulness, loyalty, staunchness, steadfastness.

Usage: Reading a friend's diary without permission would have to be regarded as the ultimate act of personal treason.

47. MEDDLE: हस्तक्षेप करना

Meaning: interfere in something that is not one's concern.

Synonyms: interlope, intrude, poke, pry.

Antonyms: shun, disregard, neglect, overlook.

Usage: Please stop meddling in your sister's life, even though you mean well.

48. STASH : छिपाने की जगह

Meaning: A store or supply of something, typically one that is kept hidden or secret.

Synonyms: hoard, stockpile, store, reservoir.

Antonyms: cast, discard, dump, jettison.

Usage: He looks around for a place to stash the dough and start a new identity.

49. SMUG : आत्मसंतुष्ट

Meaning: having or showing an excessive pride in oneself or one's achievements.

Synonyms: bighead, complacency, egotism, vainglory.

Antonyms: diffidence, bashfulness, demureness, shyness.

Usage: Because Rocky had a smug attitude during his meeting with the principal, he projected the image he was proud of his misdeeds.

50. DAFT : मंदबुद्धि

Meaning: silly; foolish.

Synonyms: balmy, bedlam, demented, deranged

Antonyms: rational, reasonable, judicious, sensible.

Usage: We were shocked that Diana was so daft to believe John's tale.
