

### Solutions

S1. Ans. (e)

Sol. A-E will perfectly fit into the blanks to make the sentence contextually correct and meaningful. Hence, **option (e)** is the right answer choice.

S2. Ans. (a)

Sol. B-E will perfectly fit into the blanks to make the sentence contextually correct and meaningful. Hence, **option (a)** is the right answer choice.

S3. Ans. (d)

Sol. C-D will perfectly fit into the blanks to make the sentence contextually correct and meaningful. Hence, **option (d)** is the right answer choice.

S4. Ans. (b)

Sol. A-D will perfectly fit into the blanks to make the sentence contextually correct and meaningful. Hence, **option (b)** is the right answer choice.

S5. Ans. (e)

Sol. A-E will perfectly fit into the blanks to make the sentence contextually correct and meaningful. Hence, **option (e)** is the right answer choice.

S6. Ans. (c)

Sol. "Not" should be removed as it is not used when lest is used in a sentence.

S7. Ans. (d)

Sol. "It" should be used before "being"

S8. Ans. (b)

Sol. "Have" should be replaced by "has" because after "many a" we use singular countable

noun and a singular Verb

S9. Ans. (b)

Sol. The usage of “more” is irrelevant as it is a double comparative.

S10. Ans. (b)

Sol. The error is in option (b). The word “Cross” should be replaced with “Crossed”. The structure for the sentence is {No sooner + had + Subject + Verb3rd form}

S11. Ans. (a)

Sol. Use ‘feel’ in place of ‘feels’ because the subject is plural.

S12. Ans. (c);

Sol. Place ‘should’ after ‘he’ because it is not in interrogative construction.

S13. Ans. (b);

Sol. Use ‘get’ in place of ‘got’ because ‘To’ is always followed by V1 excluding some exceptions.

S14. Ans. (d)

Sol. Replace ‘so’ with ‘very’ since ‘so’ is followed by ‘that’ when used as an adverb.

S15. Ans. (c)

Sol. Modal ‘should’ is followed by V1. So, ‘resorting’ should be removed and we should use ‘resort’.

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
