

Solutions

S1. Ans. (b)

Sol. The error lies in sentence (ii). 'has' should be replaced by 'have' so as to comply with the norms of subject verb agreement.

S2. Ans. (a)

Sol. The error lies in sentence (i). To make the sentence grammatically correct 'convicted from' should be replaced by 'convicted of'.

S3. Ans. (c)

Sol. The given sentence talks about a single event, as indicated by 'an unusual'. Therefore, 'phenomenon' should be used in place of 'phenomena'. Hence, option (c) is the most suitable answer choice.

S4. Ans. (c)

Sol. Among the given statement (ii) is incorrect because 'despite' is not followed by 'of'. Hence, option (c) is the most suitable answer choice.

S5. Ans. (d)

Sol. Here, the error lies in statement (iii) where 'Summonses' must be used in place of 'summons' because 'summons' is the singular form. Hence, option (d) is the most suitable answer choice.

S6. Ans. (c)

Sol. Among the given words, 'abhor' could fit in both the blanks. Hence, option (c) is the most suitable answer choice.

Abhor- to reject something very strongly; hate.

S7. Ans. (b)

Sol. Among the given words, 'Indiscreet' could fit in both the blanks. Hence, option (b) is the most suitable answer choice.

Indiscreet- having a penchant for revealing secrets or acting without subtlety.

S8. Ans. (b)

Sol. Among the given words, 'Customization' could fit in both the blanks. Hence, option (b) is the most suitable answer choice.

Customization- a modification made to something to suit a particular individual or task.

S9. Ans. (d)

Sol. Among the given words, 'Ejecting' could fit in both the blanks. Hence, option (d) is the most suitable answer choice.

Enervate- make (someone) feel drained of energy or vitality.

Ejecting- force or throw (something) out in a violent or sudden way.

Overarching- comprehensive or all-embracing.

Encompassing- surround and have or hold within.

Outgrowth- something that grows out of something else.

Disruptors- someone or something that interrupts an event, activity, or process by causing a disturbance or problem.

Impediment- a hindrance or obstruction in doing something.

Defunct- no longer existing or functioning.

S12. Ans. (d)

Sol. Among the given words, only 'Beholden' could fit in the given blank to make the statement grammatically correct and meaningful. Hence, option (d) is the most suitable answer choice.

Beholden- owing thanks or having a duty to someone in return for help or a service.

Frailty- the condition of being weak and delicate.

Infirmity- physical or mental weakness

Pioneering- involving new ideas or methods.

S13. Ans. (a)

Sol. Among the given words, only 'nuanced' could fit in the given blank to make the statement grammatically correct and meaningful. Hence, option (a) is the most suitable answer choice.

Nuanced- characterized by subtle shades of meaning or expression.

Slander- make false and damaging statements about (someone).

Affiliated- officially attach or connect (a subsidiary group or a person) to an organization.

Encounters- unexpectedly be faced with or experience (something hostile or difficult).

Quashed- reject as invalid, especially by legal procedure.

S14. Ans. (e)

Sol. Among the given words, only 'Lingering' could fit in the given blank to make the statement grammatically correct and meaningful. Hence, option (e) is the most suitable answer choice.

Lingering- lasting for a long time or slow to end.

Luxuriant- (of vegetation) rich and profuse in growth/ lush.

Mitigate- make (something bad) less severe, serious, or painful.

Jinx- a person or thing that brings bad luck.

S15. Ans. (d)

Sol. Among the given words, only 'Headwinds' could fit in the given blank to make the statement grammatically correct and meaningful. Hence, option (d) is the most suitable answer choice.

Headwinds- a wind blowing from directly in front, opposing forward motion.

Heretic- a person believing in or practising religious heresy.

Decorous- in keeping with good taste and propriety; polite and restrained.

Effeminate- (of a man) having characteristics regarded as typical of a woman/ unmanly.

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
