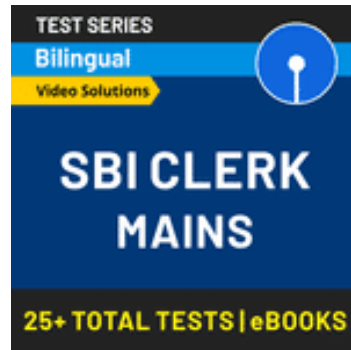

Solutions

S1. Ans. (b)

Sol. Among the given words, the most suitable rearrangement of the highlighted words will be DCBA. Also, 'depreciation' will need to be replaced with 'dissipating' to make the

statement grammatically correct and contextually meaningful. Hence, option (b) is the most suitable answer choice.

S2. Ans. (a)

Sol. Among the given words, the most suitable rearrangement of the highlighted words will be BADC. Also, '**fervor**' will need to be replaced with '**welcoming**' to make the statement grammatically correct and contextually meaningful. Hence, option (a) is the most suitable answer choice.

S3. Ans. (c)

Sol. Among the given words, the most suitable rearrangement of the highlighted words will be BACD. Also, the highlighted words are grammatically correct and contextually meaningful. Hence, option (c) is the most suitable answer choice.

S4. Ans. (a)

Sol. Among the given words, the most suitable rearrangement of the highlighted words will be BDCA. Also, '**bizarre**' will need to be replaced with '**beginning**' to make the statement grammatically correct and contextually meaningful. Hence, option (a) is the most suitable answer choice.

S5. Ans. (e)

Sol. The position of all the highlighted words is correct and thus they do not require any interchange. Moreover, the sentence is contextually correct. Hence, no replacement of any word is required. Thus option (e) is the correct answer choice.
