Q1. Which male won the highest medals in Olympics?

Ans. U.S. swimmer Michael Phelps leads all Olympians with 28 medals—23 gold, three silver and two bronze.

Q2. Who was the Viceroy of India when Jalliwala bagh 1919 Massacre took place?

Ans. Lord Chelmsford was the Viceroy of India when Jallianwala Bagh Massacre took place on April 13, 1919.

Q3. In which year State reorganization commission was constituted?
