Highlights of PM Modi Visit to Rwanda, Uganda

- India & Rwanda signed eight agreements following delegation-level talks between PM Narendra Modi & Rwandan President Paul Kagame in Kigali. The two countries signed agreements in the fields of Defence, Trade, Agriculture, Leather & allied products & Dairy. India extended two Lines of Credit of 100 million US dollars each – one for development of industrial parks & Kigali Special Economic Zone, & the other for three agricultural projects in Rwanda. Mr Modi became the first Indian PM to visit Rwanda. PM Modi also gifted 200 cows to villagers as a part of Rwandan Government's Girinka Programme.
- India & Uganda signed four MoUs. The agreements were signed following the delegation-level talks between PM Narendra Modi & Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni in Kampala. The MoUs are:

1. MoU on Defence Cooperation. 2. MoU on Visa exemption for Diplomatic & official passport holders.

3. MoU on Cultural Exchange Programme. 4. MoU on Material Testing Laboratory.

✓ Uganda Capital- Kampala, Currency- Ugandan shilling.

Rwanda Capital: Kigali, Currency: Rwandan franc.

A Brief on 10th edition of BRICS Summit

- The 10th edition of BRICS Summit held in Johannesburg, South Africa. It is a 3-day long summit & will be attended by all the BRICS leaders.
- The theme for this summit is 'BRICS in Africa: Collaboration for inclusive growth & shared prosperity in the 4th Industrial Revolution'.
- ✓ The heads of state & government of all five BRICS nations including Brazil, Russia, India, China & South Africa convened for the 10th BRICS Summit in Johannesburg, South Africa.
- The summit saw the BRICS leaders come together & discuss various international & regional issues of common concern & adopted the 'Johannesburg Declaration' by consensus.

- BRICS is made up of China, Brazil, Russia, India & South Africa.
- ✓ In December 2010, China, as the Chair, invited South Africa to join BRIC & attend the Summit in Sanya, China.
- The 1st BRIC Summit was held in June 2009 in Yekaterinburg, Russia.

The Ramon Magsaysay Award is an annual award established to perpetuate former Philippine President Ramon Magsaysay's example of integrity in governance, courageous service to the people, & pragmatic idealism within a democratic society.

Two Indians, Bharat Vatwani (for Restoring Health & Dignity to troubled lives) & Sonam Wangchuk (for Harnessing nature, culture & education) made the country proud as their names figured in the list of 2018 Ramon Magsaysay Award winners.

All About Final Draft of NRC Released By Assam

- Assam released the final draft of the National Register of Citizens (NRC), seven months after it released the first draft on 1 January 2018, which included 1.9 crore names out of a total applicant pool of 3.29 crore.
- ✓ It left out 40.07 lakh people wherein 2.89 crore people were found eligible out of 3.29 crore applicants.
- The National Register of Citizens (NRC) is the list of Indian citizens of Assam. It was prepared in 1951, following the census of 1951.

28th Meeting of GST Council| Complete Highlights



- The 28th meeting of the GST Council chaired by interim finance minister Piyush Goyal was held in New Delhi.
- The GST Council has exempted sanitary napkins from Goods & Services Tax. Earlier, there was a 12% levy of tax on sanitary napkins.
- It reduced tax rates on more than 50 items & exempted sanitary napkins, rakhis, stone, marble, wooden deities & Saal leaves from GST.
- GST on footwear priced below 1,000 rupees will attract 5% rate. GST on imported urea & ethanol sold to oil companies for blending with petrol & diesel has been reduced to 5%.
- GST rate on handbags, jewellery box, wooden box for paintings, artware of glass, stone endeavour, ornamental framed mirrors & handmade lamps were reduced to 12%.
- Lithium-ion batteries, vacuum cleaners, food grinders, mixers, storage water heaters, hair dryers, hand dryers, paint, varnishes, water cooler, milk cooler, ice cream coolers, perfumes, toilet sprays & toilet preparation have been brought to 18 from 28% slab.
- GST council has cleared 46 amendments which will be passed in Parliament. The exemption limit for traders in





Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh & Sikkim has been increased from 10 lakh to 20 lakh rupees. Note:

- GST is an Indirect Tax which has replaced many Indirect Taxes in India.
- The Goods & Service Tax Act was passed in the Parliament on 29th March 2017.
- The Act came into effect on 1st July 2017.

- South Korean President Moon Jae-in visited India. 4 This was his first visit to India. He was accompanied by First Lady Kim Jung-sook.
- The main events that took place during the visit:
- 4 President Moon attended the India-Korea business forum: Korean President Moon Jae-in spoke at the India-Korea Business Forum. This was organized by the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FICCI).
- Inaugurated World's Largest Mobile Factory In Noida: PM Narendra Modi & South Korean President Moon Jae-in visited Noida & inaugurated the New Mobile Manufacturing Plant of Samsung at Noida. Notably, it is the world's largest mobile factory. Samsung has Invested close to 5,000 Crore Rupees in this plant & aims to Manufacture 12 Crore Mobile Handsets annually which will result in massive job creation.
- India & South Korea Signed 5 MoUs In Field Of Science & Technology: India & South Korea have signed five MoUs in the field of Science & Technology in New Delhi. Science & Technology Minister. Dr Harsh Vardhan & his South Korean counterpart You Young Min signed three MoUs which are Programme of Cooperation 2018-21, Establishment of Future Strategy Group & Cooperation in Biotechnology & Bio-economy.
- India, South Korea Ink 11 MoUs: India & South Korea signed 11 MOUs during South Korean President Moon Jae-in's visit to India.
- India-Korea Technology Exchange Centre Inaugurated: The India-Korea Technology Exchange

Centre was inaugurated by the **Minister of State (I/C)** MSME Giriraj Singh & Minister of SMEs & Start-ups of Republic of Korea, Hong Jong- hak in New Delhi. The purpose of the Technology Exchange Centre is to create a platform for micro, small & medium enterprises of India & Korea where they can be assisted to identify & exchange latest technologies, share management expertise, product development & technology applications for product development.

FIFA World Cup 2018 Concludes | France Emerged as **Champions**

- **4** The 21st edition of the FIFA World Cup concluded in Luzhniki Stadium in the Russian capital of Moscow.
- 32 nations, divided into eight groups, battled it out for the coveted trophy in the quadrennial month-long event.
- 4 France emerged as the champion team of the FIFA World Cup 2018. It has defeated Croatia in a thrilling final by 4-2. It was the second world cup win for France, it first won in 1998.

Finance Ministry Approves Infusion of Rs. 11,336 Crore In 5 PSBs

 The finance ministry has approved an infusion of Rs 11,336 crore in five state-owned lenders including PNB, Corporation Bank & Andhra Bank to help them meet the regulatory capital requirement.

This is the first ever capital infusion in the current fiscal & the remaining amount of Rs 53,664 crore would be disbursed during the course of the year.

RBI To Issue New Design Rs100 Denomination Banknote



- RBI will shortly issue Rs100 denomination banknotes in the Mahatma Gandhi (New) Series, bearing the signature of Dr Urjit R. Patel, Governor, Reserve Bank of India.
- The new denomination has Motif of "RANI KI VAV" on the reverse, depicting the country's cultural heritage.
- **4** The base colour of the note is Lavender.
- The dimension of the banknote will be 66 mm × 142 mm.

All about the five-pronged strategy Project 'SASHAKT' to deal with NPAs

- The Sunil Mehta Committee, set up to look into the faster resolution of stressed assets, recommended the creation of an asset management company for the resolution of stressed loans worth more than Rs. 500 crores.
- FM Piyush Goyal announced that government has accepted a report submitted by a committee of bankers led by Punjab National Bank chairman Sunil Mehta. It recommended a five-pronged strategy Project

'SASHAKT' to deal with Non-performing Assets in the country's banking system.

- 4 The five-pronged strategy includes:
- 1. SME resolution approach, 2. Bank-led resolution approach, 3. AMC/AIF led resolution approach,
- NCLT/IBC approach, & 5. Asset-trading platform. 4.
- The Mehta Committee also proposed a Bank Led 4 Resolution Approach (BLRA) for loans between Rs. 50 & Rs. 500 crores. Under the BLRA approach, financial institutions will enter into an inter-creditor agreement to authorise the lead bank to implement a resolution plan in 180 days.

Government Approves Hike In Minimum Support Price **For Kharif Crops**

- The government has decided to sharply increase the 4 Minimum Support Price (MSP) for Kharif crops, as it responds to concerns about distress in the country's farm economy despite two years of strong monsoons.
- The MSP for common variety paddy, the most important Kharif crop, will be raised by Rs 200 over last year's Rs 1,550 per quintal.
- That works out a 13%t increase for the financial **year** ended March 2019 compared to a 5.4% increase in FY18.
- The year-on-year jump in MSP for most other Kharif 4 crops has also been far steeper than the annual increases announced over the last three years.

Finance Ministry Keeps SSS' Interest Rates Unchanged

- **The Finance Ministry** has kept the interest rates on small savings schemes, including NSC & PPF, unchanged for the July-September guarter.
- The move is aimed at matching the hardening interest rates in the banking sector.

- The ISSF Junior World Cup 2 concluded in Suhl, Germany, where 761 junior shooters gathered & competed in 22 Rifle, Pistol & Shotgun events — both individual & team.
- They represented 61 countries, piling up the impressive 4 total of 1544 starts: the highest number in the history of the Junior World Cup.
- 4 Manu Bhaker shot 242.5 points & won the gold medal in 10m air pistol event. She created a junior world record.
- 4 India & the People's Republic of China battled all along the competition for the top position in the medal board, which was eventually taken by the Indian National Team with 26 total medals: 15 golds, two silvers & nine bronzes. 4 The People's Republic of China took 2nd place with

21 podiums: six golds, nine silvers & six bronzes.

(ICA) framework to speed up the resolution of stressed assets which are under the 500-crore rupee bracket. The framework is part of the Project SASHAKT. The objective is to resolve stressed assets fast, & will primarily focus on NPAs in the 50 crore to 500 crore bracket.

- Oxigen & Fincare Small Finance Bank signed an agreement to roll out the Branchless Banking services, using Oxigen's flagship Point of Sale device called the Oxigen Micro ATM Super PoS.
- RBI licensed Bank of China to operate in India. Bank of China will now have operating offices in India. This will be the second Chinese bank to be operating in the country. UK's Standard Chartered has highest, 100 branches in India.
- Insolvency & Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) notified the Insolvency & Bankruptcy Board of India (Insolvency Resolution Process for Corporate Persons) (Third Amendment) Regulations, 2018. IBBI has mandated that a resolution professional should determine whether a corporate debtor had indulged in fraudulent transactions within a specified time period during the resolution process.
- YES Bank received final regulatory approval from SEBI to start mutual fund business. YES Asset Management (India), a wholly owned subsidiary of YES Bank, will launch fund offerings across the spectrum in both debt & equity markets over the next 6-12 months.
- ✓ ICICI Bank announced that its mortgage loan portfolio crossed the Rs 1.5-trillion milestone, making it the largest private player in the segment, & the lender is targeting to grow it to Rs 2 trillion by FY20.
- RBI announced that the licence of Alwar Urban Cooperative Bank in Alwar, Rajasthan has been cancelled as it is not in a position to pay its depositors in full as & when their claims accrue, among other reasons.
- ✓ ADB approved 503-million US Dollar lining project of the Son canal in Shahabad-Bhojpur region of Bihar which would benefit the agriculture sector.
- Dhanlaxmi Bank Limited appointed T Latha as the MD & CEO. She has taken over from G Sreeram.
- ✓ NABARD completed 36 years of service to the nation & celebrated the 37th Foundation Day on 12th July.
- ✓ HDFC securities announced the launch of Mutual Funds transactional capabilities on Facebook Messenger through their virtual assistant, Arya.
- Airtel Payments Bank received requisite approvals from RBI to begin taking new customers. Also, Aadhaarissuing authority UIDAI has allowed it to use the 12-digit unique identification number-based e-KYC.
- RBI has made it compulsory to incorporate purchaser's name on the face of payment instrumentalities like demand draft, pay order, banker's cheques & other instruments to prevent money laundering.
- ✓ The board of Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has approved the proposal for the insurer to hold a 51% stake in IDBI Bank. LIC has around 7.5% stake in LIC at

present & will acquire the remaining stake from the government.

- ✓ SBI & NABARD joined hands to provide collateral-free credit through Joint Liability Groups (JLGs) in Telangana.
- ✓ In a major farmer outreach, Kisan Mela is being organised at SBI's rural & semi-urban branches across the country to impart financial literacy to farmers.
- ✓ As a step towards women empowerment, the state's first all-women branch of Jammu & Kashmir Bank was inaugurated. The chairman of JK Bank is Parvez Ahmad.
- ✓ Jana Small Finance Bank announced the commercial launch of its banking operations, the last microfinance company to convert itself into a small finance bank, three years after RBI gave its in-principle approval.
- Repco Micro Finance Ltd, a non-banking finance company promoted by Repco Bank, received Nabard 2018 award for its service to self-help group (SHG) linkage in Tamil Nadu for the fiscal year 2017-18.
- Private Sector Lender Federal Bank has received the regulatory nod to open offices in Bahrain, Kuwait & Singapore, but is awaiting local clearances before it starts operations.

Economy Current Affairs

- ✓ Union Government reduced the minimum annual deposit requirement for accounts under Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana from Rs 1000 to Rs 250. The minimum initial deposit to open the account has also been reduced to Rs 250. The government has amended the Sukanya Samriddhi Account Rules, 2016 for the purpose.
- CCEA approved proposal for expanding the scope of Higher Education Financing Agency (HEFA) by enhancing its capital base to Rs. 10,000 crore & tasking it to mobilise Rs. 1,00,000 crore for Revitalizing Infrastructure & Systems in Education or RISE by 2022.
- Telecom Commission approved the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India's (TRAI) net neutrality recommendations that bar service providers from discriminating against internet content & services by blocking, throttling or granting them higher speed access.
- ✓ IMF cut India's GDP growth forecast to 7.3% in the year 2018 & to 7.5% in 2019.

Business Current Affairs

- Department of Telecom (DoT) given final approval to the merger of Vodafone India & Idea Cellular. The combination will be known as Vodafone Idea. It will create India's largest mobile-phone company. Vodafone will own 45.1% stake in the combined entity, while Kumar Mangalam Birla-led Aditya Birla Group & Idea shareholders would have 26% & 28.9%.
- Mobile tower arm of telecom major Bharti Airtel, Infratel received clearance from SEBI for its merger with Indus Towers.
- HCL Technologies Ltd surpassed Wipro Ltd to become India's third-biggest software services firm.



- India's richest person Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) beat Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) to become the most valued company in India.
- Tata Steel board gave the green flag to the joint venture with German steel giant Thyssenkrup. The resultant entity will be called Thyssenkrup Tata Steel BV, will be the second-largest steelmaker in European steel sector after Lakshmi Mittal's ArcelorMittal.
- Bharti Infratel, a mobile infrastructure company, got the approval of competition watchdog Competition Commission of India (CCI) for merging its operations with Indus Towers.
- World Bank Group member IFC (International Finance Corporation) invested \$100 million in Mahindra & Mahindra Financial Services Ltd. (Mahindra Finance). This would enable the Mahindra Group company to augment its growth by extending loans to individuals along with financing small & medium enterprises.
- PM Modi & South Korean President Moon Jae-in visited Noida & inaugurated the New Mobile Manufacturing Plant of Samsung at Noida. Notably, it will be one of the world's largest mobile factory. Samsung has Invested close to 5,000 Crore Rupees in this plant & aims to Manufacture 12 Crore Mobile Handsets annually which will result in massive job creation.
- ✓ BSNL unveiled the country's first internet telephony service that will allow users to dial any telephone number in India through its mobile app.
- ✓ YouTube has announced the investment of \$25 million to counter the spread of fake news on its platform.
- Microsoft & Walmart are teaming up for a strategic partnership that will take on rival Amazon in both technology & retail. The five-year agreement will see Walmart use Azure & Microsoft 365 across the company, alongside new projects focused on machine learning, artificial intelligence, & data platforms.
- Flipkart's digital payment subsidiary PhonePe has acquired Zopper Retail – a hyperlocal Point of Sale (POS) platform for small & medium businesses.
- European Union regulators slapped Alphabet-owned Google with a record 4.34 billion euro (\$5 billion) antitrust fine for abusing the dominance of its Android mobile operating system, which is by far the most popular smartphone OS in the world.
- E-commerce giant Amazon briefly crossed \$900-billion market cap for the first time in its history, becoming only the second company after Apple to achieve this milestone. Apple is currently the world's most valuable company with a market cap of \$935 billion.
- ✓ Oil & Natural Gas Corporation- ONGC- the premier Public Sector Natural gas Company approved exiting its helicopter service provider Pawan Hans by selling its entire 49%.
- Facebook confirmed it is working on a new satellite project, named Athena, that will provide broadband internet connections to rural & underserved areas.

- Ministry of Women & Child Development organized the 2nd meeting of National Council on India's Nutrition Challenges under POSHAN Abhiyaan in New Dehli under the Chairmanship of Vice Chairman Rajiv Kumar, NITI Aayog. It was declared that the month of September will be celebrated as National Nutrition Month every year.

The interim compensation will not exceed 20% of the cheque amount & will have to be paid by the drawer within 60 days of the trial court's order to pay such a compensation.
- Parliament approved a legislation to help the government bring back fugitives involved in white-collar crimes to stand trial in India. The fugitive Economic Offenders Bill, 2018 will become law after the President's assent & will empower the government to seize both local & overseas assets of alleged offenders, such as Vijay Mallya, Nirav Modi & Mehul Choksi.

- India & the United Kingdom signed an agreement on the exchange of experience by legal professionals & government functionaries for resolution of disputes before various courts & tribunals.
- ✓ India become the 69th shareholder of the European Bank for Reconstruction & Development (EBRD). This move paved the way for more joint investment with Indian companies across the bank's regions of operation.
- PM Modi laid the foundation stone of important projects, cumulatively worth over Rs. 900 crore in Varanasi. Among the projects inaugurated are the Varanasi City Gas Distribution Project & the Varanasi-Ballia MEMU train. He also laid the Foundation Stone for an International Convention Centre in Varanasi. 

- ✓ Sports Minister Rajyavardhan Singh Rathore announced that the rate of pension for sportspersons who have won medals in international competitions & have retired from active sports has been doubled from April 1. Olympic & Para Olympic medallists will get a sum of Rs 20,000 per month each, while gold medallists at World Cups & World Championships in Olympic & Asian Games disciplines will receive Rs 16,000 per month. Silver & bronze medallists at World Cups in Olympic & Asian Games disciplines will receive a sum of Rs 14,000 per month.
- Lewis Hamilton won the German Grand Prix 2018 held at Hockenheimring track in Germany.
- Tokyo 2020 Organising Committee officially launched its Olympic mascots 'Miraitowa' & Paralympic mascot 'Someity'.
- Indian driver Jehan Daruvala completed an exhilarating pole to flag victory in the FIA Formula 3 European Championship in Belgium.
- ✓ In Wrestling, Bajrang Punia has won his second consecutive international gold while Sandeep Tomar had to be content with a silver medal at the Yasar Dogu International in Istanbul, Turkey. Indian wrestlers returned with 10 medals, including seven by women, from the ranking event.
- Ace Indian shuttler Sourabh Verma lifted the Russian Open Badminton trophy at Vladivostok. In the title clash, he defeated Japan's Koki Watanabe & won his first title of the season.
- 18-year-old Indian runner Hima Das created history by becoming the first-ever Indian woman to win an athletics gold on the international stage. Hailing from Assam, Hima finished on top of the podium in the women's 400m event at the IAAF World U20 Championship in Tampere, Finland, clocking 51.46 seconds.
- ISSF Junior World Cup 2 concluded in Suhl, Germany, where 761 junior shooters gathered & competed in 22 Rifle, Pistol & Shotgun events — both individual & team. They represented 61 countries. India & the People's Republic of China battled all along the competition for the top position in the medal board, which was eventually taken by the Indian National Team with 26 total medals: 15 golds, two silvers & nine bronzes. Manu Bhaker shot 242.5 points & won the gold medal in 10m air pistol event. She created a junior world record.





- Janardan Singh Gehlot was elected the president of the International Kabaddi Federation (IKF) for the next four years.
- ✓ Former captains Rahul Dravid of India, Ricky Ponting of Australia & retired England Women wicketkeeper-batter Claire Taylor were inducted into the ICC Cricket Hall of Fame 2018 during a glittering ceremony in Dublin, Ireland. Former Team India captain Rahul Dravid has become the fifth Indian cricketer.
- Malaysian veteran Lee Chong Wei has won the Malaysian Open Badminton singles title for a historic 12th time. In the women's singles final, top seed Tai Tzu Ying from Taiwan won.
- ✓ In the summit clash of the 37th & final edition of the Hockey Champions Trophy at Breda, the Netherlands, India lost to defending champions Australia via penalty shoot-off. It was Australia's record 15th Champions Trophy title. While India won their second consecutive silver medal, hosts the Netherlands bagged the bronze medal.
- Australian captain Aaron Finch slammed 172(76) against Zimbabwe to register the highest-ever individual score in T20Is, overtaking his own record of 156 runs.
- Red Bull's Max Verstappen won the Austrian Grand Prix 2018 title in Austria. Ferrari's Kimi Raikkonen finished in the second spot.
- International Cricket Council (ICC) has introduced stricter sanctions for ball-tampering. The new regulations were introduced at its annual conference held in Dublin, Ireland. Ball-tampering has been upgraded from a level 2 to a level 3 offence. Tampering with the ball will be now penalized with a ban of up to 6 Tests or 12 ODIs.



- Union Sports Minister Rajyavardhan Singh Rathore announced that more than 34 years after coming into existence, the Sports Authority of India (SAI) has been renamed as Sports India.
- Bajrang Punia emerged champion at the Tbilisi Grand Prix in the 65kg category after outplaying Iranian

wrestler Mehran Nasiri in the final in Georgia. Meanwhile, in the 86kg category, Deepak Punia clinched a bronze with a 5-3 win over Osman Gosen of Turkey.

- ✓ At 52, Anju Khosla has become the oldest Indian woman to complete an Ironman Triathlon – one of the toughest one-day sporting events. The New Delhi resident completed her first full Ironman Triathlon, in Carinthia, Austria, in 15 hours, 54 minutes & 54 seconds.
- ✓ Indian goalkeeper PR Sreejesh will lead the 18-member Indian men's hockey squad while Chinglensana Singh Kangujam will serve as his deputy in the 18th Asian Games, which will begin in Jakarta & Palembang, Indonesia in August 2018.
- India's premier gymnast Dipa Karmakar clinched a gold medal in the vault event of FIG Artistic Gymnastics World Challenge Cup at Mersin in Turkey. This is Dipa's first medal in a World Challenge Cup.
- ✓ Indian lifter Jhilli Dalabehera bagged the bronze medal in the 2018 IWF Junior World Weightlifting Championships at Tashkent. She lifted 167 kg in the 48 kg category to finish third on the podium. Jhilli is the second woman lifter after Saikhom Mirabai Chanu in 2013 to win a medal in the Junior World Championships.
- ✓ India Women's Cricket Team Coach Tushar Arothe has stepped down from the role citing personal reasons, as per BCCI.
- ✓ India bagged four medals in the Asia Cup World Archery Ranking Tournament Stage 3 in Taipei, Taiwan. The feat comprised 3 silver medals & a bronze. India also finished joint third with Iran in the championship. India ended their campaign behind toppers Korea & hosts Chinese Taipei. Korea topped the tally with 14 medals, 8 of them being gold.
- ✓ In a departure from the norm, the Mission Olympic Cell included the entire Indian hockey team in the Target Olympic Podium (TOP) scheme, rewarding the players for their silver medal-winning performance at the Champions Trophy.
- ✓ Mohammad Kaif announced his retirement from all forms of competitive cricket. The 37-year-old Kaif played 13 Tests & 125 ODIs for India & will always be remembered for his match-winning knock of 87 at the Lord's during the epic NatWest Trophy final in 2002.
- ✓ The Indian team won four silver medals & five bronzes (total 9 medals) at the 7th World Junior Wushu Championships in Brasilia, Brazil.
- Indian boxers ruled the ring at the 36th Golden Glove of Vojvodina youth tournament, ending with seven gold medals to claim the overall top spot in the event in Subotica, Serbia. Four men & three women clinched gold medals at the tournament, which featured 17 countries. India finished first with 17 medals, including six silver & four bronze.
- ✓ Former world number one Angelique Kerber defeated seven-time champion Serena Williams in the women's singles final to clinch her first-ever Wimbledon title. Angelique Kerber hails from Germany.





- India's star shuttler PV Sindhu (seeded second) suffered a defeat to fourth seed Nozomi Okuhara of Japan in straight games inside 50 minutes to settle for runnersup spot in the Thailand Open at the Nimibutr Stadium in Bangkok. In men's singles, Kanta Tsuneyama (Japan) was the winner & Tommy Sugiarto (Indonesia) was runner up.
- Honda's Marc Marquez (of Spain) cruised to his ninth consecutive German Grand Prix victory to extend his MotoGP lead.
- Wrestler Vinesh Phogat won gold at the Spanish Grand Prix in Madrid, conceding just one point in five bouts en route to the title victory in the women's 50kg freestyle category. The 23-year-old outclassed Canada's Natasha Fox 10-0 in the final.
- ✓ Javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra has clinched a gold medal at the Sotteville Athletics Meet in France. The Indian youngster secured the top spot in the podium with an 85.17m throw.
- Planning for its next three Olympic Games, the International Olympic Committee (IOC) added seven medal events to the 2022 Beijing Winter Games, published a 2020 Tokyo Olympics schedule with no agreement on when to race swimming finals, & set a timetable to add new sports to the 2024 Paris Olympics. The next Winter Olympics will now include: women's monobob, Big Air freestyle skiing for men & women, plus mixed team events in short track speed skating, ski jumping, ski aerials & snowboardcross.
- Alisson Becker of Brazil has become the World's most expensive goalkeeper while transferring clubs from Italy's Roma to England's Liverpool for a world record £56 million.
- Shubhankar Sharma became the youngest Indian golfer to make the cut in any Major after he capped a wonderful back nine to achieve the feat at the 147th Open Championships at Carnoustie, Scotland.
- The All India Football Federation (AIFF), the governing body of football in India named India & Bengaluru FC Captain Sunil Chhetri as the AIFF Player of the Year in the Federation's Executive Committee Meeting in Mumbai.
- ✓ Fakhar Zaman recently scored a double century for Pakistan against Zimbabwe & he became the first player from Pakistan to score a double century in a one-day international. He became the quickest player in history to reach 1,000 runs in the format.
- Star sprinter Muhammed Anas Yahiya once again entered the record books as he broke his own national record to win the 400 metres race at the Cena Noveho Mesta nad Metuji meet in the Czech Republic.
- Indian badminton player Lakshaya Sen bagged the gold medal after defeating Indonesia's top-seeded Kunlavut Vitidsaran in the final match of the Badminton Asia Junior Championship in Jakarta, Indonesia.
- ✓ India won 8 medals in Junior Asian Wrestling Championship which concluded in New Delhi. The

medals comprised 2 gold, 3 silver & 3 bronze. Sachin Rathi won the gold after winning the bout in the 74-kg category. Deepak Punia then won the gold in the 86 kg category. Iran with 189 points topped the team championship. India with 173 points finished second while Uzbekistan with 128 points came third.

International Current Affairs

- Pakistan got its first-ever woman Chief Justice of a high court. Justice Tahira Safdar was named as the Chief Justice of the Balochistan High Court.
- ✓ United States eased export controls for high-technology product sales to India by elevating its status to a Strategic Trade Authorisation-1 (STA-1) country. With the move, the United States has granted India the same access as NATO allies, Australia, Japan & South Korea.
- The ninth & final meeting of Eminent Persons Group (EPG) on Nepal-India Relations concluded in Kathmandu, Nepal. EPG is a joint mechanism consisting of experts & intellectuals from India & Nepal.
- ✓ Asia's first arbitration centre specialised in intellectual property is slated to open in Tokyo in September 2018 to resolve the growing number of disputes in the region.
- The world's first digital art museum opened its doors to the public in Tokyo, Japan.
- ✓ UN member states approved a 6.69 billion US Dollar budget for 13 peacekeeping operations for the year 2018-19.
- The Mattala Rajapaksa International Airport (MRIA) would be operated as a Sri Lanka-India joint venture. The \$210 million facility, 241km south-east of Colombo, is dubbed the "world's emptiest airport" due to a lack of flights.
- ✓ UN Security Council adopted a resolution 2427, aimed at a framework for mainstreaming protection, rights, wellbeing & empowerment of children throughout the conflict cycle. Resolution 2427, strongly condemns the recruitment & use of children by parties to armed conflict as well as their re-recruitment, killing & maiming, rape & other forms of sexual violence, abductions.
- ✓ US President Donald Trump & his Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin held the first summit at Helsinki in Finland. Host Finland President Sauli Niinisto met Trump before Trump & Putin sit down to a bilateral meeting first without aides & then with their teams of support staff.
- External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj co-chaired the second joint commission meeting with her Bahraini counterpart Shaikh Khalid Bin Ahmed Bin Mohamed Al Khalifa. It was launched during a High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development at United Nations (UN) headquarters in New York.
- ✓ US State Department announced that the inaugural 'twoplus-two dialogue' between India & the United States will be held in New Delhi on September 6. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo & Defence Secretary James Mattis will travel to India for the dialogue with External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj & Defence Minister Nirmala Sitharaman.
- Myanmar joined the India-initiated International Solar Alliance (ISA), thus, becoming the 68th signatory to the Framework Agreement of the ISA that aims for optimum utilisation of solar energy.

- ✓ National Security Guard will be the first central paramilitary force to opt for e-ticketing instead of the railway warrant under an agreement signed with the IRCTC.
- ✓ India's latest frontline warship INS Trikand reached Sri Lanka in a goodwill visit. INS Trikand is a state-of-the-art warship of the Indian Navy equipped with a versatile range of weapons & sensors capable of addressing threats in all three dimensions - air, surface & subsurface.
- India's first private sector unit for manufacturing Unmanned Air Vehicles (UAV) & light bulletproof vehicles (LBPV) will be set up by DCM Shriram Industries Group on the campus of Shriram Rayons in Kota, Rajasthan.
- ✓ An MoU was signed between the Indian Army & State Bank of India on the Defence Salary Package.
- India's supersonic cruise missile (SCM) BrahMos was test fired from Odisha's Chandipur range launch pad under extreme conditions. The test was conducted in order to increase the longevity of its life. The missile can

cruise at speeds of up to Mach 3.0, or three times the speed of sound.

- Militaries of India & Pakistan will be part of a mega antiterror drill in Russia named "Peace Mission" in August 2018 which is being organised by the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO). There are four lenders from India that now rank among the world's 500 most valuable companies. HDFC Bank is followed by its housing finance cousin Housing Development Finance Corporation (HDFC), Kotak Mahindra Bank & State Bank of India.
- Reliance Industries Chairman Mukesh Ambani at the Reliance Industries' 41st Annual General Meeting announced that Reliance is India's largest payer of Goods & Services Tax (GST), Excise & Customs Duty, & Income Tax in the private sector paying Rs.9844 crore in FY18. Reliance has become the first Indian company to record PBDIT (Profit Before Depreciation Interest & Taxes) of over \$10 billion.
- Global Innovation Index (GII) has ranked India as the 57th most innovative nation in the world. The country has improved its ranking from 60th position in 2017. GII is being developed jointly by Cornell University, the Paris-based business school Insead & the World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO) in Geneva. The Top 3 Countries in Global Innovation Index are: 1. Switzerland, 2. The Netherlands, 3. Sweden.
- For the second year in a row, Andhra Pradesh has been ranked as the easiest Indian state to do business in, according to a survey. - ✓ Forbes has Released the 'Celebrity 100' list of World's Highest-Paid Entertainers. Boxer Floyd Mayweather captures the top spot on Forbes' 20th annual Celebrity 100 ranking of the world's highest-paid celebrities. From India, Akshay Kumar (40.5 million dollars) is ranked 76th while Salman Khan (37.7 million dollars) is on the 82nd spot.
- ✓ UK topped an annual global ranking of nations' soft power, with France placed second on the list of 30 countries which does not feature India. The 2018 'Soft Power 30' index, published by UK-based strategic communications consultancy firm Portland & the University of Southern California Center on Public Diplomacy, ranked Germany as third.

- Law Commission recommended that gambling & betting on sports, including cricket, be allowed as regulated activities taxable under the direct & indirect tax regimes & used as a source for attracting foreign direct investment (FDI).
- ✓ Airports Authority of India (AAI) will set up a state-ofthe-art Civil Aviation Research Organization (CARO) at Hyderabad's Begumpet Airport to find indigenous solutions to meet the challenges posed by the growing air traffic & for enhancing safety, capacity & efficiency of aircraft operations in the country.
- ✓ Union Environment Ministry issued a notification setting noise standards for all airports across the country. The rules state that busy airports a civil airport with more than 50,000 aircraft movements per year (take-off or a landing) should not exceed noise levels beyond 75 dB(A) Leq (decibels) during the daytime (6am to 10pm) & 65 dBA during the night (10pm to 6am).
