Banking Current Affairs

- ❑ RBI will soon put into circulation currency notes in one rupee denomination. New one rupee notes with predominantly pink-green on obverse & reverse in combination with other colours will be soon put into circulation. There is also a representation of One Rupee coin with rupee symbol having floral design & the surrounding design consists of the picture of 'Sagar Samrat' the oil exploration platform.
- ❑ Karnataka Bank Ltd has entered into a MoU with Life Insurance Corporation of India for selling life insurance products of LIC.
- ❑ HDFC Life announced the launch of an artificial intelligence-based application 'SPOK' that can automatically read, understand, categorize, prioritize & respond to customer emails sent to the private insurer. 'SPOK', an insurance email bot, can read customer queries within milliseconds & respond to them.
- ❑ Federal Bank, in association with Geojit, has launched a new trading platform called "Selfie" for customers. Designed & managed by Geojit, the trading platform will give its users absolute control over their investments with timely research inputs to make sound investment decisions.
- ❑ Bank of Baroda (BOB) & IFFCO rolled out their first set of co-branded debit cards for farmers as part of a novel initiative to push digitalisation & cashless economy. The co-branded debit cards, with inbuilt overdraft of Rs. 2,500 in special savings bank account, could be used for purchase of various agri products at IFFCO sale counters.
- ❑ Karnataka Bank Ltd has entered into a distribution agreement to sell the mutual fund products of HDFC Capital Asset Management Ltd (HDFCAML) during exchanged the MoU in Mangaluru, Karnataka.

Schemes/Portals/Missions Launched

- ❑ Union Minister of State (I/C) for Power, Coal, New & Renewable Energy & Mines, Shri Piyush Goyal launched the Saral Eindhyan Vitaran Application (SEVA), in News Delhi. The app is developed in-house by Coal India Limited (CIL) for power sector consumers. It aimed at increasing the Consumer Connect as well as the Transparency & Accountability in Coal dispatch.
- ❑ Human Resource Development Ministry & the External Affairs Ministry launched an online verification portal 'e-sanad' to make the document verification process easier for students who planning to study abroad. 'e-Sanad' is an initiative of the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), in association with

two other ministries with the help of Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

- ❑ The government launched new campaign called Darwaza Band for promotion of toilet usage in the rural areas across the country. Bollywood star Amitabh Bachchan leads the campaign. It also features actor, Anushka Sharma, who will be seen encouraging women to stand up for this issue in their villages & assume a leadership role.
- ❑ Union Human Resource Development Minister Shri Prakash Javadekar launched an Anti-Ragging Mobile App introduced by the University Grants Commission (UGC) in New Delhi. This mobile app will help students register complaints to counter the menace of ragging.

State in News

- ❑ Arunachal Pradesh mountaineer Anshu Jamsenpa has become the world's first woman to scale Mt Everest twice in five days.
- ❑ Maharashtra government has decided to form 'good morning' squads to monitor & prevent open defecation in villages & districts across the state.
- ❑ Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Kharagpur's Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness has signed an MoU with MP's Rajya Anandam Sansthan' (Department of Happiness) to collaborate on the development of a Happiness Index for measuring the well-being of the people of the state.
- ❑ In Uttar Pradesh, a massive immunisation drive has been launched in 38 districts to eradicate Japanese Encephalitis (JE). CM Yogi Adityanath has launched the drive from Kushinagar district.
- ❑ The Orange City (Nagpur) has become India's first city to have electric mass mobility system. It will have a

fleet of 200 electric vehicles including taxis, buses, e-rickshaw & autorickshaws, all of which will be fully owned by cab aggregator Ola.

- Vadodara, which was declared the 10th cleanest city in the country made a new Guinness world record for the maximum number of people sweeping a single venue. About 5,058 residents of the city came together to achieve the feat at the venue which was a bridge that connected Akota, an urban area.
- Manipur government has declared Dailong village of Tamenglong district as a Biodiversity Heritage Site of the state.

New Appointments

- Union Science & Technology Minister Harsh Vardhan was given additional charge of the Environment Ministry following the death of Union Environment Minister Anil Madhav Dave.
- Tata Sons has appointed Saurabh Agrawal, an investment banker who was formerly with the Aditya Birla Group, as its Group Chief Financial Officer. He will join the company from July 2017.
- Hassan Rouhani was re-elected as the President of Iran after winning Iranian presidential elections 2017.
- A 43-year-old UK entrepreneur named Rehana Ameer has become the first India-born woman to be elected as a councillor to a ward in the UK.
- Nepal PM Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda' has resigned paving way for Nepali Congress President Sher Bahadur Deuba to become the next PM.
- After appointing the new Chief Financial Officer Saurabh Agrawal, Tata Sons has appointed Shuva Mandal as the Group General Counsel.
- Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, a former Ethiopian health minister, has been chosen to head the World Health Organisation (WHO) & is the first African to do so since the creation of the United Nations agency in 1948. He replaced Margret Chan.
- Lenin Moreno was sworn in as Ecuador's president following a tight electoral race that the former vice president won on promises of maintaining the social programs of his leftist predecessor, Rafael Correa.
- United States Senate has confirmed Indian-American Judge Amul Thapar to a key judicial position on the powerful US court of appeals.
- Google's vice-president for South East Asia & India, Rajan Anandan has been appointed the new chairman of Internet & Mobile Association of India (IAMAI). He will take over from FreeCharge's co-founder & chief executive officer Kunal Shah. MakeMyTrip Chairman & Group CEO Deep Kalra has taken over as vice-chairman from music app Saavn co-founder & president Vinodh Bhat. The tenure of the new Council is for two years.

- Manipur Governor & former Minority Affairs Minister Najma Heptulla has been appointed as the Chancellor of Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi.

Economy Current Affairs

- India overtook Japan to become the second-largest steel producer in the world after China in 2016, according to data released by the International Stainless Steel Forum (ISSF).
- The government has selected five merchant bankers, including Goldman Sachs & Citigroup, to manage the government's 3 per cent stake sale in IOC (Indian Oil Corporation) which could fetch about Rs 6,000 crore to the exchequer. The other bankers who have been selected by the Department of Investment & Public Asset Management (DIPAM) for managing the stake sale are Deutsche Equities, SBI Capital Markets & ICICI Securities.
- Indian Oil Corporation has overtaken Oil & Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) to become India's most profitable state-owned company. Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Industries retained the crown of being India's most profitable private company for the third year in a row.
- Employees Provident Fund Organisation has approved hike in investment limit in exchange traded funds (ETFs) to 15%, from the existing 10%.
- The government has expanded the Banks Board Bureau (BBB) headed by former comptroller & auditor general Vinod Rai by adding two more members. Former Allahabad Bank chairperson & managing director Shubhalaxmi Panse & private equity player Pradip Shah have been inducted into the board as independent members.

Sports

- Harmanpreet Kaur, the captain of India's T20 team has become the first Indian Women cricketer to play in Kia Super League, the England T20 League.
- India captain Virat Kohli is the lone cricketer from the country to feature in the top 10 of the ICC Players Rankings for ODIs as he managed to hold on to his third spot in the batsman's chart. The top three batsmen South Africa's AB de Villiers (874 rating points), Australian David Warner (871) & Kohli (852) are separated by just 22 points.
- Barcelona striker Lionel Messi won the European Golden Shoe for a record-equaling fourth time having scored 37 goals in the Spanish league.
- Alexander Zverev defeated the world no. 2 ranking player Novak Djokovic 6-4, 6-3 to win the Italian Open, 2017. Italian open is also known as Rome Masters & Italian Championship

- Bengaluru FC defeated Mohun Bagan (2-0) to lift 38th Federation Cup football tournament at the Barabati Stadium in Cuttack, Odisha.
- Mumbai Indians lifted the 10th Indian Premier League trophy for the third time, as they recorded a scintillating 1-run win against Rising Pune Supergiant in the title clash at Hyderabad during final. Krunal Pandya from Mumbai Indians was named the man of the match.
- India's R Vaishali won the women's title with eight points from nine rounds in the Asian Continental Blitz Chess Championship in Chengdu, China.
- Olympic silver medalist P.V. Sindhu became a member of the BWF Athletes' Commission after voting closed for the four places on the representative body.
- India off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin won the coveted International Cricketer of the Year award at the CEAT Cricket Rating (CCR) International awards 2017.
- South Korea won Badminton's Sudirman Cup for the first time in 14 years with 3-2 victory over 10-time champions China at Australia's Gold Coast.
- Indian fencer C A Bhavani Devi struck gold in the Turnoi Satellite Fencing Championship at Reykjavik (Iceland).
- Ferrari's Sebastian Vettel won the 2017 Monaco Grand Prix at the Circuit de Monaco, La Condamine & Monte Carlo, Monaco.

National & International Current Affairs

- India will be having its own GPS system, 'NavIC' that will be operational in early 2018. NavIC or 'Navigation with Indian Constellation' the name given by PM Narendra Modi after the launch of Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System IRNSS-1G, is designed to provide accurate position information to users within the country.
- India & Germany inked twelve memoranda of understanding & agreements following bilateral delegation-level talks presided over by PM Narendra Modi & Germany Chancellor Angela Merkel. The

- agreements inked included nine joint declarations of intent (JDIs) & three memoranda of understanding. The agreements include collaboration in the field of digitalization, skill development, & cooperation in cyber policy. Besides, the two nations also agreed to resume the free trade talks between India & the European Union.
- PM Narendra Modi has inaugurated the country's longest bridge - the Dhola-Sadia Bridge in Assam. Mr Modi named the bridge after legendary singer Bhupen Hazarika. This three-lane, the 9.15-kilometre bridge has been built over the Brahmaputra river. It links Dhola to Sadia, both in Assam. The bridge will reduce the distance from Rupai on NH- 37 in Assam to Meka-Roing on NH-52 in Arunachal Pradesh by 165 KM.
- India's state-of-the-art high-speed train Tejas Express, which can run up to the speed of 200km per hour, has made its trip between Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus, Mumbai, & Karmali, North Goa. The 15-coach train has two classes chair car & executive chair car & is equipped with facilities like secured gangways, automatic doors, LCD screens, Wi-Fi, tea-coffee vending machines, magazines, bio-toilets, hand dryers etc.
- India announced a \$500 million line of credit to Mauritius as the two countries resolved to deepen ties in a range of areas including the maritime domain.
- Israel Aerospace Industries (IAI) has closed another major deal worth 630 million US dollar with India to supply advanced long-range air & missile defense systems for four ships of the Indian Navy. According to State-owned IAI, the contract is for supplying Long Range Surface to Air Missile (LRSAM) systems.
- Japan's cabinet approved a bill that would allow Emperor Akihito to step down, paving the way for the first abdication by a Japanese emperor in nearly two centuries.
- Japan is going to build a war museum at the hillock at Maiba Lokpa in Bishnupur district in Manipur where a Japanese camp was located during World War II.

Defence Current Affairs

- The Indian Army received two 155mm/39 caliber Ultra Lightweight Howitzer artillery guns from BAE Systems in the United States of America.
- As part of 'SIMBEX-17', the ongoing Bilateral Naval Exercise between Navies of the Republic of Singapore & India, Indian Naval Ships Shivalik, Sahyadri, Jyoti & Kamorta are participating. SIMBEX is an acronym for "Singapore-India Maritime Bilateral Exercises". This years edition of SIMBEX-17 being held in the South China Sea would be the 24th in the series.
- Union Defence & Finance Minister Arun Jaitley inaugurated the Defence Research & Development Organisation's (DRDO)'s new Aeronautical Test Range

(ATR) in Karnataka. The ATR is a facility under the Aeronautical Development Establishment (ADE) which works on a range of UAVs (unmanned air vehicles).

- United States has for the first time successfully tested its defence system against an Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM). A ground-based interceptor was launched at a California air base & shot down a mock ballistic missile. As per the Pentagon, the test comes after Pyongyang fired its ninth missile this year.

Ranks/ Indexes Released

- India has jumped 16 places in the revised United Nations World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO) rankings to settle at 24th for 2014 & 2015.
- The Visakhapatnam railway station is the cleanest, followed by Secunderabad, among the 75 busiest stations in the country. According to a survey, the report of which was released by railway minister Suresh Prabhu, the Jammu railway station occupied the third spot, while the New Delhi station was ranked at 39 among the busiest stations. The survey was carried out by the Quality Council of India. The Darbhanga railway station in Bihar was the dirtiest among the busiest stations.
- Two Indian cities – Mumbai & Kota – have been named among the world’s most crowded in a list topped by Dhaka, according to World Economic Forum (WEF) citing UN-Habitat data. Dhaka, the capital of Bangladesh, is the most crowded city on the planet, followed by India’s financial capital Mumbai. Kota in Rajasthan was ranked seventh.
- Indian tax laws are perceived to be second most complex in the Asia-Pacific region, becoming even less predictable over the last three years, according to Deloitte survey. India ranks only after China in having most complex jurisdiction for taxation & most complicated requirements of tax, the Asia Pacific Tax Complexity Survey conducted by Deloitte.
- According to India Development Report released by World Bank, India had one of the lowest female participation in the workforce, ranking 120th among 131 countries.

Important Days

- May 21st is observed as Anti-Terrorism Day in the memory of former Indian PM Mr Rajiv Gandhi who passed away on this day.
- Every year, May 22 is observed as International Day for Biodiversity or World Biodiversity Day. The theme for 2017 for World Biodiversity Day is “Biodiversity & Sustainable Tourism”
- 29 May is celebrated as the International Day of United Nations Peacekeepers. The theme for the 2017

International Day of UN Peacekeepers is “Investing in Peace Around the World”.

- World No Tobacco Day is observed around the world every year on May 31. The theme for World No Tobacco Day 2017 is "Tobacco - a threat to development."

- Faculty Exchange Agreement between National Defence College, New Delhi & National Defence College, Dhaka, Bangladesh.
- Pan-India implementation of Maternity Benefit Program- Pregnant Women & Lactating Mothers who are eligible will receive a cash benefit of Rs.5,000/- in three installments.
- Agreement between India & Tajikistan on Cooperation & Mutual Assistance in Customs Matters.
- MoU between India & Bangladesh on cooperation in the peaceful uses of outer space.
- Raising of Bonds of Rs. 2360 crores for Renewable Energy.
- Joint Declaration of Intent between Germany & India regarding cooperation in the sector of alternative medicine.
- Phasing out Foreign Investment Promotion Board.
- MoU between Spain & India on cooperation in the field of Organ Transplant Services.
- Setting up of new AIIMS in Kamrup, Assam.
- The allocation of 2.5 per cent of Central Road Fund for development & maintenance of National Waterways (NWs) by amending the Central Road Fund Act, 2000.
- State-owned telecom operator BSNL has inked a clutch of agreements with Facebook & MobiKwik as its looks to popularize the internet & its value added services among customers. Under the MoU with Facebook, Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd (BSNL) will provide connectivity for the social network’s ‘Express Wi-Fi Program’.
- Government-run Prasar Bharati has got into an agreement with Morocco’s Societe Nationale de Radiodiffusion et de Television (SNRT) to step up cooperation in the broadcasting sector. It was signed during the fifth India Morocco Joint Commission Meeting (JCM) in Rabat, Morocco’s capital.
- Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation (GCMMF) has signed an agreement with ISRO for

fodder acreage assessment using satellite observation & space technology. Under the MoU, ISRO will help in identification between food crops & fodder crops at village level & also locate suitable areas of current fallows & cultivable wastelands at village level for green fodder cultivation.

- The Minister of Defence & National Security of Fiji, Ratu Inoke Kubuabola accompanied by his delegation signed a MoU with the Minister of Defence, Finance & Corporate Affairs, Shri Arun Jaitley in New Delhi. An MoU on defence cooperation envisaging several areas of cooperation including in defence industry, military training & humanitarian assistance & disaster management was signed.

- Former PM Manmohan Singh presented now the 2014 Indira Gandhi Prize for Peace to the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO).
- Sanjay Gubbi of Karnataka & Purnima Barman of Assam have won the prestigious Whitley Award, popularly known as Green Oscars, for their efforts in wildlife conservation.
- Cochin Port Trust has received two Best Performance Awards from Ministry of Shipping for the highest growth in operating surplus & also for achieving third highest growth in cargo traffic among the major ports in the year 2016-17.
- An Indian boy has won the world's largest pre-college science competition, The Intel International Science & Engineering Fair (Intel ISEF) in the US in the environmental engineering category for his project on bio degradation of pesticides.
- Thespian Soumitra Chatterjee & Y.C. Deveshwar were conferred the Banga Samman, West Bengal's highest civilian award, by CM Mamata Banerjee.
- Rohan Chakravarty, a wildlife & environment cartoonist from India, has won WWF International President's Award 2017 for his efforts to change attitudes towards nature.
- Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII), Gujarat & ITC Ltd have won the Porter Prize 2017. ITC bags for Excellence in Corporate Governance & Integration & for its contribution in Creating Shared Value.
- Two Indian peacekeepers Rifleman Brijesh Thapa & Ravi Kumar were among 117 military, police & civilian personnel honoured by the United Nations with a prestigious UN Dag Hammarskjöld Medal which was awarded posthumously for courage & sacrifice in the line of duty.
- Pune city police have received the Federation of Indian Chamber of Commerce & Industries (FICCI) Smart Police Award for the year 2017.

- Satyabrata Rout, a professor from the Department of Theatre Arts, S N School of Arts & Communication, University of Hyderabad (UoH) has been awarded Sangeet Natak Akademi Puraskar for the year 2016.
- Uttarakhand Mountaineer Love Raj Singh Dharmshaktu has become the first Indian to summit Mount Everest a record six times.
- Actress Priyanka Chopra will be honoured with the Dadasaheb Phalke Academy Award for being an international icon. 'Internationally Acclaimed Actress' category at a ceremony.
- In 2017, the Union Health Minister of India Jagat Prakash Nadda is chosen for WHO Director-General Special Recognition Awards for accelerating India's tobacco control initiatives & taking bold measures to protect people against hazards of tobacco use.

At the conclusion of the talks, both the countries inked four important agreements in the field of education, maritime security, marine science & technology.
- PM Narendra Modi embarked on a four nation tour. Trade & commerce, economic cooperation & counter terrorism will be high on the agenda during the PM's visit to Germany, Spain, Russia & France. He will be the first Indian PM to visit Spain in almost 30 years.

Summits/Events Held

- 43rd G7 Summit was held in Taormina, Sicily, Italy. The 43rd G7 summit was the first summit for British PM Theresa May. The theme of the Italian G7 Summit 2017 is-" Building the Foundation of Renewed Trust."
- CGI (Consulate General of India) Dubai & Embassy of India in Abu Dhabi in partnership

with iSPIRIT, a nonprofit think tank will host a two-day "Start-up India Summit" in UAE.

- With an aim to bring together 32 premier educational & policy research institutions to catalyse the country's development process, government think-tank NITI Aayog hold the first Samavesh meeting.
- PM Narendra Modi will inaugurate the Annual Meetings of the African Development Bank (AfDB) on May 23, 2017. This is the first time in the history of AfDB Group that India would be hosting the Annual Meetings of the bank. The core theme of the event is "Transforming Agriculture for Wealth Creation in Africa".

Miscellaneous

- State-owned BSNL started satellite phone service through INMARSAT which will be initially offered to government agencies & later opened for others citizen in phased manner. The service will cover areas where no networks are present & be provided by INMARSAT which has 14 satellites.
- Turbo Megha Airways has become the first private airline to get a licence to fly under UDAN, the government scheme for subsidized regional flights.
- PM Modi launched various projects of Kandla Port Trust at Gandhidham in Gujarat. He unveiled plaques to mark the laying of Foundation Stone for the construction of the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Convention Centre & the development of the 14th & 16th General Cargo Berth.
- Minister of Railways Shri Suresh Prabhakar Prabhu has inaugurated the WiFi facility from Kudal Railway Station at 28 Railway Stations of Konkan Railway. Indian Railways has tied up with M/s SYSCON/JOISTER for provision of 2 Mbps peer to peer 24 hrs FREE Wi-Fi INTERNET bandwidth at 28 stations of Konkan Railway.


