Summits/Events Held- April

- Asia's largest startup ecosystem congregation, Huddle Kerala, will be held at Kovalam.
- The crucial dialogue between the three leading democratic powers (viz. India, Japan & the USA) of the Indo-Pacific region was held in New Delhi.
- The Global Logistics Summit was held in New Delhi. It was organised by the Department of Commerce, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, along with FICCI (Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry) & the World Bank Group.
- The two-day Assam Spring Festival began at the Manas National Park where visitors will get to experience the state's local food, music, handloom & handicrafts.
- Tripura hosted the first meeting of the NITI Forum- a unit of NITI Aayog in Agartala. In this meeting, Chief Ministers of all Northeastern States, Minister of Development of North Eastern Region & senior officials of NITI Aayog & Union Government joined the conclave.
- President of Nepal Bidya Devi Bhandari inaugurated an International Conference on Human Rights in South Asia in Kathmandu. The conference is organized by the National Human Rights Commission of Nepal.
- An international conference on 'Water, Environment & Climate Change: Knowledge Sharing & Partnership' started in Kathmandu, Nepal.

- The seventh edition of Home Expo India 2018, organised by Export Promotion Council for Handicrafts (EPCH), was inaugurated at India Expo Centre & Mart in Greater Noida.
- Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM 2018) has begun in London, the UK. Prime Minister Narendra Modi will take part in the event on 19th & 20th of April. The theme of the summit is 'Towards a Common Future'.
- Commerce & Industry Minister launched the Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO) GlobalLinker platform for MSME exporters in New

- Delhi. This move is aimed at assisting the Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) engaged in exports.
- Ministry of External Affairs in cooperation with the Government of Germany & the United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs (UNODA) hosted the India-Wiesbaden Conference 2018 in New-Delhi. The title of the Conference is 'Securing Global Supply Chains through Government-Industry Partnerships towards Effective Implementation of UNSC Resolution 1540'.
- The first meeting of National Council on India's Nutrition Challenges under POSHAN Abhiyaan was held today in New Delhi. The meeting was chaired by Dr Rajiv Kumar, Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog.

- PM Modi inaugurated 3rd annual meeting of Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) at Mumbai's National Centre for the Performing Arts. The theme was

- "Mobilising finance for infrastructure: innovation & collaboration".
- The three-day annual Sindhu Darshan Festival celebrations on the bank of Indus River started in Ladakh region of Jammu & Kashmir. It was organised by Sindhu Darshan Yatra Samiti & Ladakh Phandey Tsogspa, Leh.
- The 3rd Annual Meeting of the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) has begun in Mumbai. In the past, AIIB annual meetings have been held in Beijing, China, in 2016 & in Jeju, South Korea, in 2017. The theme was "Mobilising Finance for Infrastructure: Innovation & Collaboration".
- Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FICCI) along with several industry members & senior government officials & academia, recently participated in X International IT Forum at Khanty-Mansiysk, Russia.
- PM Narendra Modi will inaugurate the 3rd Annual Meeting of the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) in Mumbai. The theme for this year's meeting is "Mobilising Finance for Infrastructure: Innovation & Collaboration".
- An International Conference on Information & Communication Technology (ICT) will be held in Kathmandu, the capital of Nepal. The Theme was "Sustainable Development Goals for Smart Society".
- 11th World Hindi Conference will be held in Mauritius in August 2018 with an aim to increase the popularity of Hindi globally. The main theme of the Conference is 'Hindi Vishwa Aur Bharatiy Sanskriti'.
- 4th meeting of the Governing Council of NITI Aayog held under the chairmanship of PM at Rashtrapati Bhavan in New Delhi. It was attended by 23 CMs & the Lieutenant Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, apart from Union Ministers, who are ex-officio members & special invitees. States were called up to fix growth targets for their economies as the world looks towards India soon becoming a USD 5 trillion economy.
- 5th National Standards Conclave- Implementing the Indian National Strategy for Standardization held in New Delhi. It was organized by Department of Commerce & Confederation of Indian Industry (CII).
- 15th annual Asia & Oceania Region Inter-Governmental Ministerial meeting on anti-doping was held in Colombo with representatives from 29 countries including India.
- 44th G7 summit was held on June 8–9, 2018, in Quebec, Canada. This was the sixth time since 1981 that Canada has hosted the meetings. The 44th G7 summit was the first summit for Italian PM Giuseppe Conte. Canadian PM Justin Trudeau has hosted this summit. The 45th G7 summit or next G7 summit will be held in 2019 in France.
- The Eleventh edition of Geo-Intelligence Asia 2018 organized by GeoSpatial Media & Communication with Directorate General of Information System as Knowledge Partners & Military Survey as Co-organisers,



- took place in New Delhi. The theme was 'Geo-Spatial: A Force Multiplier for Defence & Industrial Security'.
- The two-day 49th Conference of Governors concluded in New Delhi. The President exhorted Governors to take the lead in adopting modern technology & methods.

- The first Nepal-India Think Tank Summit has begun in Kathmandu to foster greater collaboration and knowledge-sharing among the think tanks of the two countries. Former PM of Nepal and Co-chairman of ruling Communist Party of Nepal, Pushpa Kamal Dahal Prachanda inaugurated the summit.
- 3rd BRICS Film Festival took place in Durban, South Africa, along with the International Durban Film Festival (DIFF). The last day of the festival (27th July) was celebrated as India Country Day.
- International Union of Food Science and Technology (IUFoST), the global voice of food science and technology in association with Indian National Science Academy (INSA) as adhering body, announced the 19th edition of its prestigious global event to be held in Navi Mumbai, India in October 2018. The focal theme is 25 Billion Meals a Day by 2025 with Healthy, Nutritious, Safe and Diverse Foods.
- NITI Aayog, in collaboration with various ministries and industry partners, is organising 'MOVE: Global Mobility Summit' in New Delhi in September 2018. This Summit will help drive Government's goals for vehicle electrification, renewable energy integration and job growth and also speed up India's transition to a clean energy economy.
- 5th Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) Intersessional ministerial meeting was held in Tokyo, Japan. It was first RCEP ministerial gathering to be held outside ASEAN countries.
- Commerce Secretary, Rita Teaotia, chaired the first meeting of the Task Force on e-commerce in New Delhi.
- The 2nd meeting of the joint working group on tourism cooperation between India and Nepal concluded in Kathmandu, Nepal. The meeting also decided to set up an industry-led India Nepal Tourism Forum.
- HRD Minister Prakash Javadekar inaugurated the 17th World Sanskrit Conference held at Vancouver,

- Canada. The purpose of this conference is to promote, preserve and practice the Sanskrit language all over the world by the people.
- Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI) organised a two-day International Round Table Conference on 'Data for New India' in New Delhi. Such a Conference was organized in India for the first time. The objective was to identify innovative ideas for improving the statistical system in India.
