CWG 2018 Concludes: Australia Tops Medal Tally, India Third

- The 21st edition of the Commonwealth Games will begin in Gold Coast, Australia, with a colourful opening ceremony. This will be a momentous day for the city as the biggest event in its history begins.
- Carrara Stadium has been chosen as the venue to host the opening ceremony. These Games will mark the 5th time that Australia has hosted the games. India will be represented at the opening ceremony by a contingent of over 200 athletes who will be led by flag-bearer P V Sindhu.
- India finished third in the medals tally at the Commonwealth Games 2018 with 66 medals (26 Gold, 20 Silver & 20 Bronze). Australia with 198 medals & England with 136 were ahead. India's 26 Golds was also third, behind Australia (80) & England (45). India's combined 66 medals is its third-best showing in the history of the Games.
- India's best remains 101 in New Delhi (2010), followed by 69 in Manchester (2002). India bettered its showing in Glasgow 2014, where we finished fifth overall, by just two medals.

Modi in Sweden on 1st leg of 3-nation visit

- PM Modi left for Sweden on the first leg of his threenation tour of Europe.
- This was the first prime ministerial visit from India to Sweden in 30 years after the visit of Rajiv Gandhi in 1988.
- G Modi held a bilateral summit with Swedish Prime Minister Stefan Lofven.
- India & Sweden also co-host the first ever India-Nordic Summit, where the Prime Ministers of the other four Nordic countries of Denmark, Finland, Iceland & Norway were present.
- PM Modi held a roundtable with top Swedish CEOs Companies in Sweden, the largest Nordic economy in Europe has committed a fresh 1.1 billion dollars investment in India. He Signed various agreements with Sweden, Denmark & Iceland.

Modi in the UK on 2nd leg of 3-nation visit:

- PM Modi addressed the world in a globally broadcast live event called 'Bharat Ki Baat, Sabke Saath' from the iconic Central Hall Westminster in London.
- PM Modi & 52 other leaders attended the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) at the Buckingham Palace in London. He joined other heads of government for the leaders' retreat at Windsor Castle, which concluded the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) in the UK.
- PM Modi also held bilateral talks with his British counterpart Theresa May. Counter-terrorism cooperation was the main agenda of discussion. Modi & May agreed to take "decisive & concerted actions" against terrorism in all its manifestations.
- Mr Modi also paid floral tributes at the bust of 12thcentury Lingayat philosopher & social reformer Basaveshwara at Albert Embankment Gardens on the banks of the river Thames.
- At the special invitation extended by Prince Charles, Modi became the first Indian PM to attend the event in a decade.

Modi in Germany on 3rd & last leg of 3 nation visit:

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi held bilateral talks with German Chancellor Angela Merkel in Berlin & discussed ways to further strengthen the strategic partnership between the two countries.
- It was third & the last leg of Modi's three-nation tour to the UK, Sweden & Germany. The PM arrived in Delhi from Berlin.



- An MoU on Skill Development, Vocational education & Training & seek to promote greater collaboration in domains such as strengthening skill delivery in high demand sectors where UK has technical & skilling expertise.
- A Statement of Intent between NITI Aayog & UK's Department of Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy (BEIS) has also been signed.
- Inked the deal on cooperation in the field of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries Sectors seeking to strengthen collaboration in livestock health & husbandry, breeding, dairying & fisheries.

Banking, Economy & Business Related Current Affairs

- 1. SIDBI (Small Industries Development Bank of India) has celebrated its foundation day on 2nd April 2018. Chairman Managing Director of SIDBI Mohammad Mustafa launched a series of initiatives from its Lucknow bank headquarters. Chairman SIDBI also launched 'Samridhhi- the virtual assistant' on banks revamped universal loan portal <u>www.udyamimitra.in</u>.
- **2.** Jana Small Finance Bank (formerly Janalakshmi Financial Services) announced commencement of its banking operations.
- **3.** In a bid to prevent the possibility of manipulation in the prices of securities, especially government securities (G-Secs), the Reserve Bank of India has changed the methodology used by debt market players, including banks & primary dealers, for their valuation. As per a central bank directive, security/bond valuation will be based on the weighted average price of the last half-an-hour of trading on the last trading day of every quarter against the last traded price earlier.
- 4. An MoU was signed between the Indian Army & HDFC Bank on the Defence Salary Package. Under the current MoU apart from other benefits the Army personnel will get free personal accident death cover & free permanent disability cover of Rs 30 lakhs, free educational cover of upto Rs 1 Lakh per year for four years for education of dependent child in case of accidental death of defence personnel & 100% processing fees waived for Car Loans & Personal Loans.
- 5. Jio Payments Bank Limited commenced operations as a payments bank. RBI has issued a licence to the bank under Section 22 (1) of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 to carry on the business of payments bank in India.
- **6.** Private sector lender IndusInd Bank has received RBI's approval to buy the securities services arm of IL&FS.
- 7. The Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) decided to keep the policy repo rate under the liquidity adjustment facility (LAF) unchanged at 6.0%. India's real gross domestic product (GDP) growth marginally upward to 6.6% from 6.5% in the first advance estimates. CPI inflation excluding food & fuel remained unchanged at 5.2%.
- 8. In a move that could temporarily soften bond yields, the Reserve Bank of India, in consultation with the Government, hiked the foreign portfolio investors (FPI) investment limit in Central government

securities (G-Sec) from 5% of outstanding stock now to 5.5% in FY2019 & 6% in FY2020.

- **9.** Deutsche Bank AG named Christian Sewing as the Chief Executive officer of the Bank. He has replaced John Cryan. Sewing will take over with immediate effect.
- **10.** RBI switched back to the gross domestic product (GDP)-based measure to offer its growth estimates from the gross value added (GVA) methodology, citing global best practices.
- **11.** India's foreign exchange reserves hit a life-time high of 424.361 billion US dollar after rising by 1.828 billion dollar in the week to March 30, according to the Reserve Bank of India data.
- **12.** SBI has announced the launch of its UK subsidiary, SBI (UK) Limited, with an initial capital commitment of 225 million pounds from its parent entity.
- **13.** State Bank of India will be investing a total of Rs 80 billion in the Arun III hydropower project of Nepal, which has 900 megawatts (MW) electricity production capacities.
- **14.** Jammu & Kashmir Bank has launched a special financing scheme named 'Add-on Working Capital GST' to help the state industry cope with the delay in reimbursement of GST under special tax relief.
- **15.** National E-Repository Limited (NERL), a group company of National Commodity & Derivatives Exchange Limited (NCDEX), has brought in ICICI Bank & HDFC Bank on board as the repository participants for pledge finance.
- **16.** Reserve Bank of India tightened reporting norms for the Liberalised Remittance Scheme (LRS) under which an individual can transfer up to USD 2,50,000 abroad in a year. The LRS transactions are currently permitted by banks based on the declaration made by the remitter.
- **17.** Small Industries & Development Bank of India (SIDBI) announced a plan to promote micro-enterprises in 115 aspirational districts across the country. It has tied up with Common Service Centre (CSC).
- **18.** State-run Punjab National Bank (PNB) launched new products such as pre-approved credit card & UPI solution to mark its 124th foundation day.
- **19.** Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) has announced that it expects India's gross domestic product (GDP) to grow at 7.3-7.7% during the 2018-19 financial year.
- **20.** As part of the drive to double the income of farmers by 2022, the government has raised the authorised capital of NABARD by six times from 50 billion to Rs 300 billion to help it increase its lending to the rural economy.







- **21.** Shares of private lender Kotak Mahindra Bank Ltd beat India's largest lender State Bank of India (SBI) for the first time to become the second most valued bank in the country. Data from BSE showed that Kotak Mahindra Bank has a market capitalization of Rs2,22,560.69 crore after its shares rose 1.7%.
- **22.** Yes Bank has announced the launch of 'Yes GST', an OD (over draft) facility for Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs). Through this, an MSME can avail OD up to Rs 1 crore, based on their annual turnover, backed by GST returns.
- **23.** State Bank of India (SBI) has come up with an alternate & convenient method of cash withdrawal for its customers. The bank is now providing facilities of cash through 'Cash@POS' initiative.
- 24. National Bank for Agriculture & Rural Development (NABARD) has extended total credit support of Rs 14,690 crore to Rajasthan for 2017-18. Rajasthan has been one of the biggest beneficiaries under the Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) of NABARD, during 2017-18.
- **25.** Private sector lender Yes Bank has received the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) approval to open two representative offices in London & Singapore.
- **26.** Reserve Bank of India has revised "Know Your Customer" or the KYC guidelines. The KYC norms have been revised following the government's decision to update the 'Prevention of Money Laundering' rules in June 2017. The RBI made linking of national biometric ID Aadhaar to bank accounts mandatory. However, it said this will be subject to the final decision of the Supreme Court on making of Aadhaar mandatory.its
- **27.** Indian Overseas Bank (IOB) entered into an agreement for information utility services with the National E-Governance Services Limited (NeSL).
- **28.** State-run Bank of India (BoI) has entered into an agreement with National E-Governance Services (NeSL) for information utility (IU) arrangement under the Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code (IBC).
- **29.** Paytm Payments Bank now has over 100 million KYC wallets, against the constant campaigning done by the bank about the benefits of the Know Your Customer (KYC) system.
- **30.** National Stock Exchange of India (NSE) has announced the launch of its "e - Gsec" platform for facilitating the non-competitive bidding in Government of India Dated Securities (G-Sec) & Treasury Bills (T-Bills). This will allow retail investors to invest in Government Securities & hold them in existing demat accounts.
- **31.** According to the Development bank NABARD, it has provided an assistance of Rs 10,012 crore to Uttar Pradesh during 2017-18 to facilitate overall development with special focus on agricultural credit.

- **32.** HDFC Bank launched IRA 2.0, its interactive humanoid at the Koramangala Branch in Bengaluru. The interactive humanoid in its advance version is aimed to enhance user experience for customers visiting in the branch. It has developed IRA (Interactive Robotic Assistant) 2.0 in collaboration with its technology partners Invento Makerspaces & Senseforth Technologies.
- **33.** Looking to provide an impetus to early-stage startups, markets regulator Securities & Exchange Board of India (SEBI) decided to double the investment limit by angel funds in venture capital undertakings to Rs10 crore from the current Rs5 crore.
- **34.** With the beginning of the financial year 2018-19, the eway Bill System for Inter-State movement of goods comes into force. Under this system businesses & transporters have to produce before a GST inspector eway bill for moving goods worth over Rs 50,000 from one state to another.
- **35.** The government has amended Income Tax rules that will now allow transgenders to be recognised as an independent category of applicants for obtaining a Permanent Account Number (PAN) for their tax-related transactions.
- **36.** Asian Development Bank (ADB) has projected that India's economic growth is set to rise to 7.3% this fiscal & further to 7.6% in the next financial year, on back of GST & banking reforms.
- **37.** The World Bank has projected a growth rate of 7.3% for India this year & 7.5% for 2019 & 2020. The bank also noted that Indian economy has recovered from the effects of demonetisation & the Goods & Services Tax.
- **38.** International Monetary Fund (IMF) has stated that India is expected to grow at 7.4% in 2018 & 7.8% in 2019 & would re-emerge as one of the fastest growing major economies in the period.
- **39.** According to the Deutsche Bank research report, the Indian economy is witnessing a "cyclical upswing" & the country is likely to clock a GDP growth of 7. 5% this financial year. Reserve Bank expects India's economic growth rate to strengthen to 7.4% in the current fiscal, from 6.6% in 2017-18, on account of revival in investment activity.

- **41.** SoftBank has signed a \$930-million deal with China's energy conglomerate Golden Concord (GCL) to produce & sell solar equipment in India.
- **42.** Homegrown e-commerce giant Flipkart has forged a strategic partnership with online travel company MakeMyTrip to offer travel services on its platform.
- **43.** Digital payments company PayPal & the Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO) signed an



agreement for the promotion of outbound shipments among small & medium enterprises (SMEs) leveraging the partners' expertise & technology products.

- **44.** Tata Consultancy Services has created the history as the market capitalisation of the company has hit the 100 billion dollar mark, making it the first Indian IT company to achieve the mark. TCS joined the ranks of the world's 100 most valued organizations & now ranks 97th. The last Indian name to cross that threshold in 2007 was Reliance Industries Ltd.
- **45.** One97 Communications Limited, the owner of digital payment major, Paytm, announced the launch of its offline payments solution the Paytm Tap Card, in line with the company's vision to provide seamless payments solutions for non-internet customers. This card uses Near Field Communication (NFC) technology to enable safe & convenient digital payments.

- **11.** Launching the 'Gram Swaraj Abhiyan' in Telangana, the Union Minister for Petroleum & Natural Gas Dharmendra Pradhan stated the number of LPG distribution points in the State will be increased to 1,000 from the existing 707 for quicker & efficient delivery of gas cylinders.
- **12.** The Union Government has stated that the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana or PMGSY is well on its way to achieving the target by March 2019. The scheme, since its inception in 2000, has been able to provide connectivity to more than One lakh 50 thousand habitations.
- **13.** Minister of Communications Manoj Sinha launched the DARPAN (Digital Advancement of Rural Post Office for a New India)-PLI App, which will help in collection of premium for Postal Life Insurance (PLI) & Rural Postal Life Insurance (RPLI) policies at Branch Post Offices anywhere in India, with online updation of the policies.
- 14. Indian Government has launched the 'Study in India' initiative to attract international students to study in India. The website of Study in India can be accessed at www.studyinindia.gov.in. External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj & Minister of State for Human Resources Development Satya Pal Singh jointly launched the initiative in New Delhi.
- **15.** Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu has launched a health scheme of the Assam government named Atal





Amrit Abhiyan that offers free medical care of up to 2 lakh rupees for every individual from Below Poverty Line (BPL) & Above Poverty Line (APL) families. The state government has earmarked 400 crore rupees for the scheme in the financial year 2018-19.

- **16.** Gujarat police unveiled the Pocket Cop project, which will enable quicker verification of passport applicants, & search of accused persons, among others. The project was inaugurated by Chief Minister Vijay Rupani in Gandhinagar. Under the project, smartphones with data connectivity will be given to 4,900 police personnel, including every police station in-charge, investigating officer, PCR van, & those involved in passport verification.
- **17.** Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs Vijay Goel inaugurated the new office of Central Project Monitoring Unit for the e-Vidhan project of the Government at the Parliament House Annexe. e-Vidhan is a part of the broader Digital India Programme of the Government & is likely to contribute to the cleanliness & environment by reducing the use of papers to a great extent.
- **18.** Ministry of Human Resource Development (HRD) has launched integration of e-SANAD portal & NAD National Academic Depository in a bid to make education system in India more transparent. e-Sanad is a project aimed at online submission & verification of documents with the ultimate object to extend contactless, cashless, faceless & paperless document attestation service. NAD is a 24X7 online storehouse of all academic awards viz. diplomas certificates, degrees, mark-sheets etc.
- **19.** Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has approved a restructured Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan scheme aimed at making rural local bodies selfsustainable, financially stable & more efficient. PM Narendra Modi will launch Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan scheme in Mandla in Madhya Pradesh on the occasion of National Panchayati Raj Day.
- **20.** Hardeep Puri, Minister of State for Housing & Urban Affairs (I/C) launched a Mobile App (m-Awas) for allotment of Government accommodations in General Pool Residential Accommodation (GPRA) in Delhi under the control of the Directorate of Estates. The application has been developed by NIC.
- **21.** Ministry of Human Resource Development, HRD launched the second edition of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan under which students from 750 higher educational institutions from across the country will adopt villages & visit them to get acquainted with the lifestyle of people there & the problems faced by them.

- **1.** India is now the second-largest mobile phone producer in the world after China as per the data shared by Indian Cellular Association with the government.
- **2.** The Union Cabinet has given its approval to the Protection of Human Rights (Amendments) Bill, 2018 for better protection & promotion of human rights in the country. The features of the Bill are as follows:
- **3.** It proposes to include "National Commission for Protection of Child Rights" as deemed Member of the Commission; It proposes to add a woman Member in the composition of the Commission; It proposes to enlarge the scope of eligibility & scope of selection of



Chairperson, National Human Rights Commission as well as the State Human Rights Commission; & It proposes to incorporate a mechanism to look after the cases of human rights violation in the Union Territories.

- 4. President Ram Nath Kovind has asked Indian Diaspora in Zambia to become the partner in India's growth & asked them to take advantage of Overseas Citizen of India, OCI programme. Four MOUs were signed between the two countries which include, the establishment of Entrepreneurship Development Institute in Zambia, taxation, visa exemption on diplomatic passports & judicial cooperation. This is the first time in three decades that a President of India is undertaking a state visit to Zambia.
- 5. Prime Minister Narendra Modi left on a five-day visit to Sweden & the UK. The visit to the two nations aims at enhancing bilateral cooperation in key areas like trade, investments & Science & technology. On the first leg of his visit, the Prime Minister will attend the first-ever India-Nordic Summit at Stockholm, which will be co-hosted by India & Sweden. In London, Mr Modi will take part in the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting being hosted by the UK.
- 6. The Union Cabinet approved the promulgation of the Fugitive Economic Offenders Ordinance 2018, which would empower the government to seize the domestic assets of those deemed by a relevant court to be fugitive economic offenders. The Ordinance has a provision for a 'Special Court' under the Prevention of Money-laundering Act, 2002 to declare a person as a Fugitive Economic Offender.
- 7. The Minister of Housing & Urban Development Hardeep Singh inaugurated the 48th Foundation Day of Housing & Urban Development Corporation (HUDCO) on 25th April. HUDCO is playing an important role in taking financial inclusion forward in the country, as it is taking care of the housing finance needs of the economically deprived sections.
- 8. India has agreed for the most revered Buddhist relics from Sarnath to be taken to Sri Lanka for public exposition on the occasion of Vesak festival. This is the first time relics from Sarnath are being brought to Sri Lanka from India, & special arrangements have been made for this purpose.
- **9.** Prime Minister Narendra Modi arrived in New Delhi after a two-day informal summit meeting with Chinese President Xi Jinping in Wuhan. PM Modi wrapped up his two-day visit to China with both the countries underlining the importance of maintaining peace & tranquillity.
- **10.** With an aim to combat the rising levels of air pollution in Delhi-NCR region, petrol pumps in the capital started supplying ultra-clean Bharat Stage VI grade fuel (both petrol & diesel). This move makes New

Delhi the first city in the country to switch from BS-IV grade fuels to BS-VI.

- **11.** R K Singh, Minister of State (IC) for Power & New & Renewable Energy, laid the foundation stone of the 60 MW Naitwar Mori Hydro Electric Project (NMHEP) along with Uttarakhand Chief Minister Shri Trivendra Singh Rawat in Uttarkashi.
- **12.** Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath inaugurated a 10.30-km-long elevated road, touted to be the longest of its kind in the country, connecting UP Gate & Rajnagar Extension, Ghaziabad.
- **13.** Patna tops in 4G connectivity among 20 of India's largest cities. It has emerged ahead of the likes of Bengaluru, Mumbai & Delhi, according to the report of OpenSignal, a wireless coverage mapping company.
- **14.** Prime Minister Narendra Modi flagged off India's first all-electric high-speed locomotive in Bihar. The first big Make-in-India project completed by France's Alstom, the train has the country's most powerful engine with 12,000 horsepower & a maximum speed of 120 km/hr.

- **16.** A Loan Agreement for IBRD loan of USD 48 million for the "Meghalaya Community - Led Landscapes Management Project (MCLLMP)" was signed with the World Bank.
- **17.** The much-awaited bridge 'Ib Setu' built over the Ib river in Sambalpur district was thrown open to the public by Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik. The 2.5-km-long bridge, which is the State's second longest bridge, has been built in three years at a cost of Rs. 117.50 crore.
- **18.** State-run Gujarat Narmada Valley Fertilizers & Chemicals Limited (GNFC) started its socio-economic Neem Project, inaugurated by Union Minister Smriti Irani in Amethi District of Uttar Pradesh.
- **19.** West Bengal has once again topped in the country with Digambarpur Gram Panchayat (GP) bagging the Centre's award for the best Gram Panchayat in the country.
- **20.** The Union Home Ministry completely revoked the controversial Armed Forces Special Powers Act (AFSPA) from Meghalaya while diluting it in other regions of Arunachal Pradesh.
- **21.** Diu Smart City has become the first city in India, that runs on 100% renewable energy during daytime setting a new benchmark for other cities to become clean & green.
- 22. West Bengal government has given its approval to State Forest Department to apply for coveted Ramsar Site recognition under Ramsar Convention to Sunderban Reserve Forest. Now, State Forest

Department through Central Government will apply to Ramsar Convention Secretariat. Once it is conferred Ramsar site status, Sundarbans Reserve Forest will be largest protected wetland in the country. There are currently 26 sites in India recognised as Ramsar wetland sites of international importance.

- **23.** Asian Development Bank (ADB) has agreed in principle to give an aid of 1,700 crore rupees to Uttarakhand for infrastructure development & creation of sewerage treatment facilities in urban areas.
- 24. Home Ministry has decided to relax the six-decade-old Protected Area Permit regime from Nagaland, Mizoram & Manipur for five years. Foreign tourists, except those from Pakistan, China & Afghanistan, will now be allowed to visit some of the most pristine locations of the country which, so far, were out of bounds for them without a special permit.

American John Isner won his first ever Masters 1,000 title with a victory over German Alexander Zverev in the Miami Open final. S. Stephens won in the Women's singles category.
- **2.** Kerala has lifted their sixth Santosh Trophy Football title. In a thrilling final at the Salt Lake Stadium in Kolkata.
- 3. The 21st edition of the Commonwealth Games begun in Gold Coast, Australia, with a colourful opening ceremony. Carrara Stadium has been chosen as the venue to host the opening ceremony. These Games marked the 5th time that Australia has hosted the games. India was represented at the opening







ceremony by a contingent of over 200 athletes who were led by flag-bearer P V Sindhu.

- **4.** Weightlifter & current world champion Mirabai Chanu has clinched India's first gold medal of the 2018 Commonwealth Games. Mirabai Chanu becomes the first Indian to win a gold medal at the Commonwealth Games 2018.
- 5. On the first day of competitions at the Gold Coast Commonwealth Games 2018, in Australia, India began their campaign with a Silver Medal in Weightlifting. In the 56 kilogram category, P Gururaja lifted a total weight of 249 kg to finish second in the event.
- 6. Weightlifter Khumukcham Sanjita Chanu has delivered India its second gold medal of the 2018 Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast City, Australia by dominating the women's 53kg event.
- 7. Teenager Deepak Lather became the youngest Indian (18 Yrs old) weightlifter to claim a Commonwealth Games medal, clinching a bronze in the men's 69kg category.
- 8. Indian women's cricket team captain Mithali Raj has become the most capped player in women's ODI cricket after turning out for the 192nd time against England.
- **9.** India's 16-year-old Manu Bhaker won the gold in women's 10 air pistol while Heena Sidhu staged a remarkable recovery to secure silver at the 21st Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast. Bhaker shot 240.9 to break the Commonwealth Games record.
- **10.** Indian tennis' ageless wonder Leander Paes became the most successful doubles player in the history of Davis Cup as he combined with Rohan Bopanna to not only grab a record 43rd win but also bring the country back in the tie against China.
- **11.** Weightlifter Sathish Sivalingam won India's third gold medal in the ongoing 21st Commonwealth Games.
- **12.** Ferrari's Sebastian Vettel won his second Grand Prix in as many races, at the Bahrain Grand Prix, while Mercedes' Valtteri Bottas finished second by just 0.699 seconds.
- **13.** Jitu Rai broke the games record to claim the gold medal by some distance in men's 10m air pistol, at the 21st Commonwealth Games. Om Prakash Mitharval bagged bronze in the same event. India's 17-year-old shooter Mehuli Ghosh set a Commonwealth Games joint record to win silver in the women's 10m Air Rifle event. India's 25-year-old shooter Apurvi Chandela won a bronze medal in the same event.
- **14.** India clinched their first-ever badminton mixed team event gold in Commonwealth Games history after defeating defending champions Malaysia 3-1 in the final at Gold Coast.
- **15.** India defeated Nigeria to clinch gold in the men's table tennis team event at the Commonwealth Games for the first time since 2006.

- **16.** India's weightlifter Punam Yadav won gold in the Women's 69kg weightlifting category. Yadav lifted a combined total of 222kg (100 snatch & 122 clean & jerk) & defeated England's Sarah Davies her closest competitor to take her second medal at the Commonwealth Games.
- **17.** India has bagged three more Gold, one Silver & two bronze medals at the 21st Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast. Indian women's Table Tennis team won their first ever Gold Medal defeating Singapore. Manika Batra led Table tennis team's.
- **18.** Indian shooter Heena Sidhu set Commonwealth Games record to win gold in women's 25m pistol shooting event. This is Sidhu's second medal at CWG 2018, after winning silver in women's 10m air pistol.
- **19.** Indian shooter Shreyasi Singh won the women's double trap gold in a shoot-off after scoring 96 points to take India's gold medal tally at the 21st Commonwealth Games 2018 to 12.
- **20.** Indian shooter Om Prakash Mitharval settled for the bronze medal in the men's 50m pistol event at the 21st Commonwealth Games at Gold Coast, Australia.
- **21.** Kidambi Srikanth has become the first Indian male badminton player to attain the world number one ranking since Prakash Padukone in the 1980s.

- 24. Tejaswini Sawant won India its fifth shooting gold medal at the 2018 Commonwealth Games, winning the women's 50m Rifle 3 Positions Finals in Gold Coast, Australia. India's Anjum Moudgil won silver at the event, after having topped qualification.
- **25.** Fifteen-year-old shooter Anish Bhanwala became India's youngest gold medalist at the Commonwealth Games, winning the men's 25m Rapid Fire Pistol Finals with a record score at Gold Coast, Australia.
- **26.** Nineteen-year-old Naman Tanwar won India its first boxing medal at the 2018 Commonwealth Games, winning a bronze in the men's 91 kg category.
- **27.** Wrestler Bajrang Punia won his first Commonwealth Games gold medal, defeating Wales' Kane Charig by technical superiority in the men's freestyle 65 kg final in Gold Coast, Australia.
- **28.** Shooter Sanjeev Rajput won the men's 50m Rifle 3 Positions with a Games record at the 2018 Commonwealth Games to seven.



Keeping the unbeaten streak, Indian women whitewashed the championship by beating host Nepal in the final of team events. India topped the medal tally winning 10 Gold & 3 Bronze medals in the individual category. Host Nepal remained second & Pakistan got third place.
- **41.** Rafael Nadal has won his 11th Barcelona Open title on clay. He defeated the 19-year-old Greek Stefanos

Tsitsipas to clinch the title. Nadal who also won his 11th Monte Carlos Masters title recently.

- **42.** Five-time Ballon d'Or winner Lionel Messi netted a hat-trick as Barcelona defeated Deportivo to clinch the La Liga for the seventh time in 10 years & the 25th time in their history.
- 43. 56th edition of Belgrade International Boxing Championship was held at Belgrade in Serbia. Indian boxers won three gold, five silver & five bronze medals at this championship. Among Gold medal winners, Sumit Sangwan won the final bout by defeating Ecuador's Castillo Torres in 91 kg category. Indian woman boxer Nikhat Zareen won the Gold medal in 51 kg bv defeating Greece's Koutsoeorgopoulou Aikaterini in the final bout. 1. The presidents of Iran, Turkey & Russia met for their second tripartite summit in under six months, aiming to speed the peace process for Syria & bolster their influence in the country. Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan hosted his Russian & Iranian counterparts Vladimir Putin & Hassan Rouhani in



Ankara for a meeting that could have a critical bearing on developments in Syria.

- 2. Singapore & China signed an MoU in Beijing, China to promote greater collaboration between Singapore & Chinese companies in third-party markets along the Belt & Road.
- 3. India & World Expo 2020 signed participants contract for India's pavilion in the prestigious World Expo 2020 held once in 5 years. The contract provides for the setting up of India pavilion at Expo 2020 on an extra large plot (about one acre) in the 'Opportunity' segment.
- **4.** Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has decided to scrap the quota system in government services after thousands of students marched across the country in protest against a controversial policy of setting aside jobs for special groups.
- **5.** World Bank has approved \$55mn to expand the use of clean renewable energy in rural areas of Bangladesh where grid electricity cannot reach easily.
- 6. United Nations' Deputy Secretary-General Amina Mohammed announced the launch of the 'UN Road Safety Trust Fund' to stimulate action that can save lives & prevent injuries & sufferings associated with road accidents.
- 7. United Kingdom joined the India-led International Solar Alliance (ISA) ahead of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's four-day visit to Britain.
- 8. The Jatra begins in Nepal. It is believed that the festival started during Malla dynasty. In Nepal, the famous Bisket Jatra is being celebrated in Bhaktapur & other parts of Kathmandu valley.
- **9.** Since 2016, fourteen new sites have been designated as Globally Important Agricultural Heritage Systems (GIAHS), including the first ones in Europe.
- **10.** India has won an election to a crucial nongovernmental organisation committee in the United Nations. It topped the election held by the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations in the Asia Pacific States category. The Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations is a standing committee of Economic & Social Council (ECOSOC).
- **11.** Swaziland's King Mswati III, Africa's last absolute monarch, officially changed the name of his country to the 'Kingdom of eSwatini'. Accordingly, the country, a member of the Commonwealth, will now be known by its historic name of eSwatini.
- **12.** Britain's Prince Charles will succeed his mother Queen Elizabeth II as the Head of the Commonwealth after the heads of government agreed on his succession.
- **13.** The Commonwealth countries have unanimously agreed to take action on cybersecurity by 2020. In a landmark declaration at the end of Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) in London, the leaders of 53 countries agreed to work closely to

evaluate & strengthen their cybersecurity frameworks & response mechanisms.

- 8. The garden city of Bengaluru is found to be the highest paying city in the country, with an average annual cost to company (CTC) for talent across all levels & functions standing at about Rs 11 lakh, according to Randstad Insights, the research & analysis division of Randstad India.
- **9.** India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP), the worth of the economy, clocked in at \$2.6 trillion for 2017, according to the database of the International Monetary Fund's World Economic Outlook (WEO) for April 2018. India is now the world's sixth largest economy, displacing France. The Top 3 economies of the world are: 1. The United States, 2. China, & 3. Japan.
- **10.** As per the 2018 Commonwealth Innovation Index, India fetched 10th position in the index topped by the United Kingdom, Singapore & Canada. The index was launched on the sidelines of the ongoing Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) as part of a new Commonwealth Innovation Hub.
- **11.** In India, Bangalore has emerged as the most preferred city for office expansion, according to a survey by real estate consulting firm, CBRE South Asia.
- **12.** According to the TRA Brand Trust Report 2018, the State Bank of India was the most-trusted bank (both public & private sector) in the country & ICICI Bank topped the chart among the private ones. This year, State Bank of India tops the chart of BFSI (Banking & Financial Services Institutions) super-category despite seeing a dip in its overall brand trust index ranking. The leader among the private banks is ICICI Bank,





rising nine ranks in overall ranking, it ranked 38th overall in 2018.

- **13.** The TIME Magazine released the 100 Most Influential People List of 2018 designating individuals whose time is now. The 2018 list features the names of four self-made Indians- Bollywood actress Deepika Padukone, Indian cricket captain Virat Kohli, Ola cofounder Bhavish Aggarwal & Microsoft's CEO Satya Nadella.
- 14. India is poised to remain the fastest growing large economy in the world, & its GDP is expected to reach \$5 trillion by 2025, Economic Affairs Secretary Subhash Chandra Garg has told the World Bank in the 97th meeting of the Development Committee of the World Bank in Washington, USA.
- **15.** India has retained its position as the top remittances receiving country with its diaspora sending about \$69 billion back home in 2017, according to the report of the World Bank. The list has been topped by Norway. North Korea was at the bottom-most position (180th) in the list. The Top 3 countries in World Press Freedom Index Report are: 1. Norway, 2. Sweden, 3. The Netherlands.
- **18.** Technology giant Microsoft India has been declared the most attractive employer brand, followed by ecommerce giant Amazon India. The winners were named by HR service provider Randstad's Employer Brand Research (REBR) 2018. Sector-wise, Tata Consultancy Services is most favoured in IT, while Larsen & Toubro tops Infrastructure & Construction & Hindustan Unilever emerges the winner in FMCG.
- **19.** Online search engine Google is the most trusted Internet brand in India, followed by Facebook, as per the TRA Brand Trust Report 2018. With 1.2 trillion searches per year, Google has become the first port of call for all things on the Internet. Google was followed by Facebook, Amazon & eBay.

- **4.** Closure of loss-making Burn Standard Company Limited - a Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE)-Decision taken in view of the continuous poor physical and financial performance of the company for more than 10 years combined with low probability of its revival in the future,

- 5. Cabinet apprised of MoU between India and United Arab Emirates on Technical Cooperation in Rail Sector,
- 6. Demerger and transfer of surplus land from Tata Communications Limited (TCL) to Hemisphere Properties India Ltd. (HPIL),
- 7. Rightsizing the Competition Commission of Indiafrom 1 Chairperson and 6 Members (totalling seven) to 1 Chairperson and 3 Members (totalling four) by not filling the existing vacancies of two Members and one more additional vacancy.

- **19.** Minimum Support Prices for Raw Jute for 2018-19 season- The Minimum Support Price (MSP) for Fair Average Quality (FAQ) of Raw Jute has been increased to Rs.3700/- per quintal for 2018-19 season from Rs. 3500/- per quintal in the 2017-18 season.
