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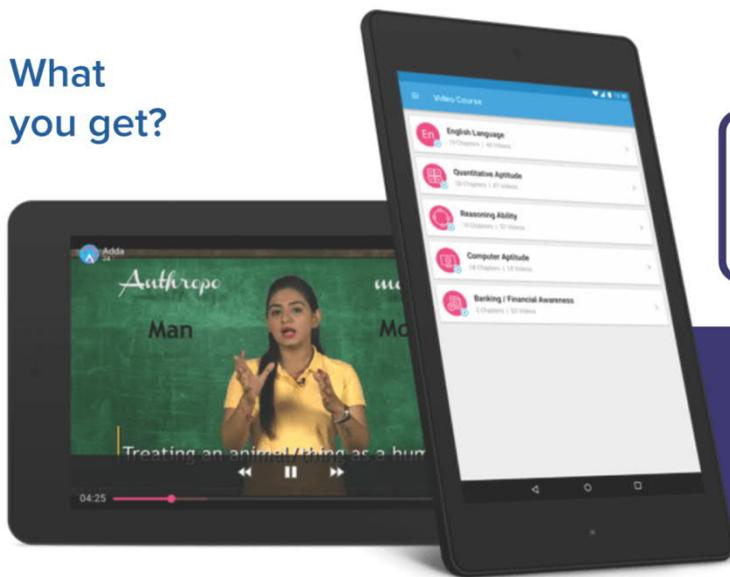
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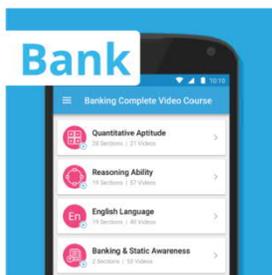


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Solutions

S1. Ans.(b)

Sol. Japanese capital city Tokyo has topped The Economist Intelligence Unit's Safe Cities Index 2017, which ranked 60 cities on parameters including personal and health security. Pakistani city Karachi has been ranked the least safe city in the list.

S2. Ans.(e)

Sol. Chennamaneni Vidyasagar Rao is present Governor of Maharashtra.

S3. Ans.(a)

Sol. The Indian Air Force (IAF) launched an innovative health mobile App named 'MedWatch' on the occasion of its 85th anniversary. It was launched by Air Chief Marshal BS Dhanoa during the Air Force Commanders' Conference in New Delhi. The Mobile app was launched to keep up with the Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of 'Digital India'.

S4. Ans.(e)

Sol. An FVCI can invest in an Indian company engaged in:-

1. Biotechnology
2. IT related to hardware and software development

4. Seed research and development

S5. Ans.(d)

Sol. Communications Minister Manoj Sinha launched the Sampoorna Bima Gram (SBG) Yojana and an initiative for expansion of clientele base of Postal Life Insurance (PLI). Under Sampoorna Bima Gram (SBG) Yojana, at least one village (with min. 100 households) will be identified in each of the revenue districts of the country. Coverage of all households is the primary objective of this scheme.

S6. Ans.(e)

Sol. The Capital city of Odisha, Bhubaneshwar is known as Temple City of India.

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S7. Ans.(b)

Sol. Veteran and one of India's eminent historian Satish Chandra passed away the age of 95. Satish's important works include Mughal Empire and its downfall. He was also the author of NCERT's leading history book 'History of Medieval India'.

S8. Ans.(c)

Sol. A foreign currency convertible bond (FCCB) is a type of corporate bond issued by an Indian company in an overseas market in a currency different from that of the issuer. Investors have the option of redeeming their investment on maturity or converting the bonds into equity any time during the currency of the bond.

S9. Ans.(e)

Sol. MobiKwik, mobile wallet major, and a payment gateway provider announced the appointment of Rukaiya Rangwala as the Business Head of 'MobiKwik Payment Gateway' to drive the growth of the entity. The company had recently relaunched its Payment Gateway and aims to have over \$5 billion worth of transactions processed on the platform by the end of 2017-18.

S10. Ans.(d)

Sol. Santiago is the Capital of Chile. Michelle Bachelet is the present President of Chile.

S11. Ans.(c)

Sol. The first International Day of Rural Women was observed on 15th October 2008. This new international day, established by the UN General Assembly in its resolution 62/136 of 18th December 2007, recognizes "the critical role and contribution of rural women, including indigenous women, in enhancing agricultural and rural development, improving food security and eradicating rural poverty."

S12. Ans.(a)

Sol. According to accepting public deposits, NBFCs can be classified into two broad categories, viz.,
(i) NBFCs accepting public deposit (NBFCs-D)
(ii) NBFCs not accepting/holding public deposit (NBFCs-ND).

S13. Ans.(a)

Sol. The world's largest combustion research center was inaugurated at the Indian Institute of Technology, Madras (IIT-M) in Tamil Nadu. The National Centre for Combustion Research and Development (NCCRD) was inaugurated by NITI Aayog member VK Saraswat.

S14. Ans.(e)

Sol. Afghani President Ashraf Ghani was on a national visit to India. During his visit, he met with the president Ram Nath Kovind and PM Modi. India and Afghanistan have agreed to work closely with the regional and international partners to further the objective of seeing Afghanistan emerge as a stable, peaceful, united and prosperous nation.

S15. Ans.(b)

Sol. Going digital, the Rajasthan assembly has become the first in India to call attention and adjournment motions and proposals online from legislators to send them to the state government. Speaker Kailash Meghwal has inaugurated the new system by sending a call for an attention motion to the state government with a click of the mouse.

S16. Ans.(c)

Sol. Stock Holding was incorporated as a Public Limited Company in 1986. It has been jointly promoted by leading Banks and Financial Institutions. Stock Holding is a subsidiary of IFCI Limited. The equity capital of Stock Holding is presently held by LIC, GIC, IFCI Ltd., SU-UTI, NIA, NIC, UIC, and TOICL, all leaders in their respective fields of business.

S17. Ans.(c)

Sol. Roger Federer has brushed aside world number one Rafael Nadal 6-4 6-3 to win the Shanghai Masters and register his fourth victory of the year over his Spanish rival. The Swiss world number two beat Nadal in the finals of the Australian Open and Miami Masters and in the last 16 at Indian Wells earlier this year, and never looked like losing to his long-time rival in Shanghai, firing 10 aces as he cruised to victory.

S18. Ans.(a)

Sol. Premier all-rounder Shakib Al Hasan became the first cricketer from Bangladesh to be inducted in the MCC World Cricket Committee under the chairmanship of Mike Gatting. Also added to the committee are Suzie Bates, Ian Bishop and Kumar Dharmasena.

S19. Ans.(a)

Sol. Former President Pranab Mukherjee has released the third part of his memoir 'The Coalition Years: 1996-2012', speaking candidly about believing he could have been the Congress choice for the Prime Minister's post. Mukherjee's memoir is the third in the series. The other two are -- The Dramatic Decade: The Indira Gandhi Years and The Turbulent Years: 1980-1996.

S20. Ans.(c)

Sol. National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) is the parent organisation of UPI (Unified Payment Interface).

S21. Ans.(d)

Sol. The South Pacific island nation of Vanuatu has become host to the world's first government to accept bitcoin in exchange for citizenship. Vanuatu's citizenship program costs \$200,000 USD, meaning that at current prices the residency program costs less than 41.5 bitcoins.



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S22. Ans.(d)

Sol. Union Bank of India has launched an Android app, Union Sahyog, as part of its drive to digitise customer-facing banking services. The Union Sahyog app is bilingual — offering both English and Hindi language — and packs in all mobile-based banking applications, missed call/SMS-based services, Internet banking login and self-user creation, deposit and loan product information, online account opening, online loan application, online complaints and even RTI.

S23. Ans.(e)

Sol. The Union Ministries of Power and Textiles have jointly launched an initiative 'SAATHI' (Sustainable and Accelerated Adoption of efficient Textile technologies to Help small Industries). Under this initiative, Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL), a public sector entity under the Union Ministry of Power, will acquire energy efficient Powerlooms, motors and Rapier kits in bulk and provide them to the small and medium powerloom units. Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani is the Cabinet Minister of Textiles of India.

S24. Ans.(e)

Sol. Abu Dhabi Global Market (ADGM), the International Financial Centre in Abu Dhabi, and Yes Bank have signed a memorandum of understanding to further foster cross-border exchange between the fintech ecosystems of the United Arab Emirates and India.

S25. Ans.(c)

Sol. NPA stands for Non-Performing Asset.

S26. Ans.(b)

Sol. Rajkiran G Rai is present Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and Managing Director of Union Bank of India.

S27. Ans.(d)

Sol. India beats Malaysia 2-1 in the finale to win the 2017 Asia Cup Hockey tournament held in Dhaka, Bangladesh. This was India's third continental title. Ramandeep Singh scored the opening goal in the third minute while Lalit Upadhyay extended India's lead in the 29th minute of the game.

S28. Ans.(d)

Sol. The ASHA or the Accredited Social Health Activist. ASHA will be the first port of call for any health related demands to access health services. ASHA will be a health activist in the community who will create awareness on health and its social determinants and mobilize the community towards local health planning and increased utilization and accountability of the existing health services in Rural areas.

S29. Ans.(c)

Sol. Gaganjeet Bhullar had completed a wire-to-wire victory and lifted his eighth Asian Tour title at the Macau Open. He drained five birdies on the front nine and won by three shots despite a nerve-jangling double bogey.

S30. Ans.(c)

Sol. The Jaipur and Srinagar Airport got First and Second rank respectively in the category of 2-5 million passengers in ACI-ASQ Survey. Dr. Guruprasad Mohapatra, Chairman, Airports Authority of India along with his team received the ACI-ASQ Award at a function held in Mauritius.

S31. Ans.(a)

Sol. In physics, radiation is the emission or transmission of energy in the form of waves or particles through space or through a material medium.

S32. Ans.(b)

Sol. Gujarat-cadre IPS officer Rakesh Asthana was appointed the special director of the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).

S33. Ans.(a)

Sol. India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) has appointed Mr. Suresh Sethi as its Managing Director & Chief Executive Officer. Mr Sethi was the former MD of Vodafone M-Pesa Ltd. Mr. Sethi takes over from the dynamic leadership of Mr. A.P. Singh who had been the interim MD & CEO of IPPB since January 2017.

S34. Ans.(d)

Sol. Infrastructure Finance Company (IFC) is a non-banking finance company has a minimum Net Owned Funds of Rs.300 Crore.

S35. Ans.(d)

Sol. The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation (HSBC) has announced the appointment of Jayant Rikhye as the Chief Executive Officer for India. The appointment would be effective from December 1 subject to regulatory approvals.

S36. Ans.(c)

Sol. Central American country Nicaragua has signed the Paris Agreement on climate change, leaving the United States and Syria as the only two countries holding out to sign this global climate pact. According to Nicaragua's President Daniel Ortega, the Paris Agreement is the only international mechanism that offers the conditions to face global warming and its effects.

S37. Ans.(d)

Sol. The Union Cabinet has approved the biggest ever highway project to develop and expand approximately 83,000 km of roads at an investment of Rs 6.9 lakh crore by 2022. The project also includes the new Bharatmala highway program connecting border areas, improving international, port and coastal connectivity.



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S38. Ans.(a)

Sol. An NBFC must be registered with the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) and have specific authorization to accept deposits from the public.

S39. Ans.(c)

Sol. The Asian Development Bank and the Government of India signed a \$300 million loan to continue a series of fiscal reforms in the State of West Bengal to improve the quality of public service delivery. The Program aims to further deepen the reforms with focus on expenditure rationalization, improvement in revenue administration, and facilitation of more private investment in the state.

S40. Ans.(c)

Sol. Indian Navy Ship Sukanya under the command of Commander SA Deodhar has arrived at Belawan Indonesia to participate in the 30th edition of CORPAT (Coordinated Patrol) and 3rd Bilateral exercise between the Indian Navy and the Indonesian Navy.

S41. Ans.(a)

Sol. RNBCs stands for Residuary Non-Banking Companies.

S42. Ans.(b)

Sol. Reliance Communication had received the final approval on its merger with Sistema from the Department of Telecommunication (DoT). This merger will also extend validity of RCom's spectrum portfolio in the highly valued 800 and 850 MHz band in eight major telecom circles across the country - Delhi, Gujarat, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala, Kolkata, UP-West and West Bengal - by a period of 12 years from 2021 to 2033.

S43. Ans.(e)

Sol. The Swift code consists of 8 or 11 characters. When 8 digits code is given, it refers to the primary office and 11 digits code refers to branch office.

S44. Ans.(a)

Sol. Eminent classical singer and Padma Vibhushan awardee Girija Devi died in Kolkata. She was 88 years old. She was considered as the "Queen of Thumri" and fondly called Appa Ji. She was from the "Benaras Gharana".

S45. Ans.(e)

Sol. The LEI is a global reference number that uniquely identifies every legal entity or structure that is party to a financial transaction, in any jurisdiction. It is a unique 20 digit alphanumeric code that is assigned to a legal entity.

S46. Ans.(e)

Sol. SWIFT stands for Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunication. SWIFT provides a network that enables financial institutions worldwide to send and receive information about financial transactions in a secure, standardized and reliable environment.

S47. Ans.(c)

Sol. The travel guide company Lonely Planet has ranked Chile as the number one country to visit in 2018 in its Best in Travel 2018 list. The guide has published the 13th edition of its annual list of the top 10 countries every traveler should have on their bucket list for 2018. Chile was the only South American country to earn the top spot on the list.

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
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
