- ♣ Balal village in Kasargode district in the state of Kerala is one of the 21 villages selected across the country by the State Bank of India under the SBI Digital Village initiative.
- ♣ State Bank of India launches two new digital offerings. SBI has partnered with Flipkart to offer its consumers the facility of pre-approved EMI Facility on purchases. The bank also launched a social media banking platform for Facebook & Twitter users, called 'SBI Mingle'.
- ♣ SBI & the World Bank have inked agreements for a \$625 million (around Rs 4,200 crore) facility to support grid-connected rooftop solar programme (GRPV) in the country.
- Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs approved an increase in foreign investment from the current approved level of 62% to 74%.
- SBI Cards & Payment Services (SBI Card), the thirdlargest card issuer by number has launched a premium credit card 'Elite'. Elite is a bundle of several privileges & benefits for high net worth individuals (HNIs).
- ♣ SBI, has signed a MoU with the Indian Institute of Technology Society for Innovation & Entrepreneurship (SINE), (IIT) Bombay's technology business incubator, to promote innovation by startups in the financial sector.
- IDFC Bank has announced it had acquired Tamil Naduheadquartered microfinance institution GramaVidiyal in an all-cash deal.
- Housing Development Finance Corp (HDFC) is set to become the first Indian company to sell masala bonds, a rupee-denominated bond sold to foreign investors & listed on an overseas exchange.
- RBI has constituted an inter-regulatory Working Group (WG) to study the entire gamut of regulatory issues relating to Financial Technology & Digital Banking in India. The Working Group will be headed by Sudarshan Sen, Executive Director of RBI.
- RBI has asked banks to exchange up to 20 pieces of soiled currency notes with a maximum value of Rs. 5,000 over the counter free of charge.
- The fourth tranche of the Sovereign Gold Bonds scheme has opened for subscription.
- The government has allocated Rs 22,915 crore capital to meet the capitalization needs of 13 Public Sector Banks (PSBs) in the current fiscal.
- SBI launches Rs 7,000 crore stressed assets fund with Brookfield.
- Federal Bank has signed an agreement with Reliance Jio Money for one-click payment service.
- Indian Railway Catering & Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) has joined hands with the State Bank of India to chalk out a detailed plan for promotion of rail ticketing activities, including internet ticketing & unreserved ticketing system.
- Corporation Bank has launched a new facility called 'Green PIN'.
- ICICI Bank Ltd has organised a coin exchange mela during the 'RathYatra' festival at the RBI financial literacy camp in Bholanath Vidyapith.

- RBI has imposed a penalty of Rs. 5 crore on Bank of Baroda in the alleged rs. 6,000 croreforex related irregularities that were observed in October last year.
- ICICI Bank & Axis Bank are the first Indian banks to sign up for Swift's global payments innovation initiative.
- ♣ RBI has imposed penalty of Rs 2 crore each on Allahabad Bank & UCO Bank & Rs 1 crore on Bank of India for violation of anti-money laundering norms. It has also imposed an aggregate penalty of Rs. 2 crore on Canara Bank.
- ♣ RBI has imposed 27 crore rupees penalty on 13 public & private sector banks for violations of Foreign Exchange Management (FEMA) Act (Anti-money laundering) & lapses in Know your customer (KYC) rules. The maximum penalty for Rs 5 crore has been imposed on Bank of Baroda.



- ♣ State Bank of India has launched a payment system at its ATMs which will allow the account holders to transfer the money by using the mobile phone number as an identifier. This payment facility system works on instant money transfer (IMT) platform which will enable a payment of up to Rs 10,000 from any SBI bank.
- ♣ Japanese payments company OKI has installed 600 automatic teller machines with cash recycling abilities for country's largest lender State Bank of India across the country.
- ♣ ICICI Bank has announced a 0.05% reduction in its marginal cost of funds based lending rate (MCLR).

- RBI has set up a committee to look at the various facets of household finance in India & to benchmark India's position vis-à-vis both the peer countries & advanced countries. This will be chaired by Dr. Tarun Ramadorai.
- RBI has imposed the penalty on two cooperative banks of Chhattisgarh under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949. Zila Sahakari Kendriya Bank Maryadit, Raipur, & Raipur Urban Mercantile Cooperative Bank Limited are the banks on which the penalty of five lakh rupees each are imposed.
- Corporation Bank has launched 'group credit life insurance scheme' of LIC of India in Mangaluru. The scheme covers various term loans, including retail loans & loans to MSME & agriculture.
- ♣ IDFC Bank has appointed former RBI (RBI) deputy governor Anand Sinha to the bank's board.

- US multinational banking firm Goldman Sachs says Indian economy is likely to grow 7.9% in this year 2016-17.
- World Bank has announced a funding of Rs 980 crore to dredge the Brahmaputra as an initiative to develop waterways to Bangladesh & to other South East Asian countries which is give fillip to trade & industry.
- The RBI, in its Annual Report, has projected India's growth rate at 7.6% in 2016-17, up from 7.2% last year.
- NABARD has sanctioned a loan of Rs 204.67 crore under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) for rural infrastructure in Haryana for projects including a 10 MW solar plant at Panipat thermal power station.


- Ending a 92-year-old tradition which started during the colonial era, Railway Budget will be merged with the General Budget from 2017-18 onwards.






