
#### **National Current Affairs**

- ♣ To help Indian business explore economic opportunities in Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar & Vietnam (CLMV), the Union Cabinet has given its go-ahead for a Project Development Fund (PDF) with a corpus of Rs 500 crore.
- India jumped 19 places in the Logistics Performance Index to rank 35th in this year's list. The logistics' list was topped by Germany.
- On the occasion of the 55th Teachers' Day Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal inaugurated Asia's biggest digital library dedicated to the memory of Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, former President of India, in NIT Silchar.
- Bandaru Dattatreya, the Minister of State for Labour & Employment inaugurated the first phase of Telemedicine services of ESIC in New Delhi for providing specialist medical services at a distance to insured workers.
- The Union Minister of State Dharmendra Pradhan has launched Gas4India campaign for the aimed at promoting the use of gas in the country.
- The government has approved projects worth over Rs. 450 crore under 'Swadesh Darshan' scheme for five states.
- India has received certificates from World Health Organisation recognising the elimination of Yaws & Maternal & Neonatal Tetanus (MNT) from the country.
- India's ranking on the World Economic Forum's Global Competitiveness Index for 2016-17 has improved 16 places to 39, making it the fastest riser among the 138 nations surveyed. topped the rankings, followed by Singapore and the US.
- Mexico has set up its consulate in south India in Chennai that will cater to Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana.
- ♣ The Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries in the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers welfare has declared India free from Avian Influenza (H5N1).
- India has slipped by 10 positions to 112th, out of 159 countries & territories, according to the Economic Freedom of the World: 2016 Annual Report. Hong Kong has the highest level of economic freedom worldwide.

- Canada's British Columbia province has become the first foreign government to issue of masala bonds, a rupeedenominated bond. It had issued Rs 500 crore rupee
