


INDIA IN NEWS

- ✦ Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched a campaign to boost the morale of soldiers by sending Diwali greetings under the #Sandesh2Soldiers campaign on the Narendra Modi App, through MyGov.in, and also through All India Radio.
- ✦ PM Narendra Modi has launched national Schedule Castes/Schedule Tribes hub in Ludhiana. With an initial outlay of Rs 490 crore, the hub will work towards strengthening market access/linkage, monitoring, capacity building, leveraging financial support schemes and sharing industry-best practices.
- ✦ India donated Rs. 9.3 million to the Nelson Mandela Foundation to help it in its welfare work for the people of South Africa.
- ✦ Maharashtra CM Devendra Fadnavis inaugurated India's first centre for international arbitration in Mumbai. The Mumbai Centre for International Arbitration (MCIA) will initially be located at Express Towers.
- ✦ The Union Cabinet has approved "mini Ratna" public sector undertaking HLL Lifecare to sub-lease its land for setting up the country's first medical devices manufacturing park.
- ✦ India formally joined the Paris Climate Change Agreement by submitting its instrument of ratification in New York (UN Headquarter). India became the 62nd country to ratify the agreement. Main Motive of the COP summits is to monitor & encourage countries to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. COP22 will take place at Marrakech in Morocco, 2016.
- ✦ The Indian government has invited the Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan to be the next Chief Guest at India's Republic Day parade of 2017. This is the first time that a leader of the United Arab Emirates will be honoured with the invitation of being the Chief Guest at India's Republic Day parade.

STATES IN NEWS

- ✦ Maharashtra is the top State in the implementation of agricultural reforms and offers the best environment for doing agri-business, according to an assessment by the Niti Aayog.
- ✦ Chief Minister of Kerala Pinarayi Vijayan has launched paddy cultivation in Aranmula Pancha near Cochin.
- ✦ Punjab government will observe November 1 as 'No Tobacco Day' in an effort to discourage tobacco use in the state.
- ✦ India's first 'Design Yatra' conducted in Kerala's Kozhikode city during which competitions, heritage walk, talks and interaction with students will be conducted and it is scheduled to travel to 29 Indian cities.

- ✦ Himachal Pradesh was declared 'Open Defecation Free', becoming India's second state to get this status after Sikkim.
- ✦ Maharashtra government launched 'Kaushalya Setu', a skill development programme for students in Mumbai.
- ✦ Bihar government is set to introduce a "Lok Samvad" programme in an effort to get public feedback and suggestions.
- ✦ Haryana Government has decided to observe 2017 as the "Garib Kalyan Varsh. During the observation period of Garib Kalyan Varsh, the government would lay emphasis on welfare of poor people and generating employment opportunities for the youth.
- ✦ Kochi became the first city in the country to be confirmed as a venue for next year's World Cup which will be Kerala's first in any sport.
- ✦ PM Narendra Modi has inaugurated 3 hydro-electric projects with a generating capacity of 1,732 MW in Himachal Pradesh. The three hydropower projects are:
 - 540 MW generation capacity third phase of Parbati hydropower project of NHPC in Kullu district.
 - 412 MW Rampur project of Satluj Jal Vidyut Nigam Ltd in Shimla.

- ✦ India's 29th state, Telangana's map was redrawn on 11 October 2016 with the creation of 21 new districts, With these, the total number of districts of the youngest state of India went up to 31.
- ✦ With an aim to make Madhya Pradesh anaemia-free, the state government has decided to launch a scheme-'Lalima Abhiyan'- that will be effective from November 1. Under the campaign, free iron folic acid tablets will be provided in aagan wadis', academic institutions & hospitals.

- ✦ Playback singer K J Yesudas has been roped in by the Kerala' government as the brand ambassador of its ambitious 'Haritha Keralam' project. 'Haritha Keralam' (Green Kerala) project, a massive initiative envisaged for a garbage-free & clean state.
- ✦ Jharkhand has become the first state in the country to implement Direct Benefit Transfer in Kerosene.
- ✦ Delhi Police has launched a mobile application for senior citizens to enable them to reach out to the police quickly in emergency situations. The application 'Delhi Police Senior Citizen' was launched by Delhi Lt. Governor Najeeb Jung & Police Commissioner Alok Kumar Verma.
- ✦ Gujarat's 900-year-old Rani ki Vav (the Queen's Stepwell) has been named as the 'Cleanest Cultural Heritage Site' in the nation. Further, Surat was named as the cleanest railway station, & Chandigarh's Post Graduate Institute of Medical Research & Education was named the cleanest hospital. Himachal Pradesh's Mandi district was named the cleanest district in hilly areas, while Maharashtra's Sindhudurg district was named the cleanest in plain areas.
- ✦ Chief Minister Pema Khandu flagged off a 10-member all-women Mt Gorichen Expedition led by Anshu Jamsempa. It will be the first all women team attempting to summit the second highest peak of Arunachal Pradesh (6488 mtr).
- ✦ Sikkim's capital Gangtok has been conferred with the title of the 'Cleanest Tourist Destination' in India by the Ministry of Tourism. Further, Chandigarh & Mysore were felicitated as 'Clean Cities' in the 'million plus population' category.
- ✦ Canara Bank has bagged awards for excellence in MSE Lending, Lending to Micro Enterprises and in the field of Khadi and Village Industries.
- ✦ According to the data released by the RBI, India' banking system reported total deposits of Rs. 100 lakh crore for the first time ever in September month of this year. With demand deposits crossing Rs10 lakh crore & time deposits crossing the Rs 90 lakh crore mark, the month saw the highest-ever monthly rise of Rs 5.32 lakh crore.
- ✦ State-run Bank of Maharashtra has renewed its corporate agency tie-up with United India Insurance Company.
- ✦ Standard Chartered Bank has announced a tie-up with Uber under which its credit cardholders, across six countries, will get a cash-back of up to 25 per cent for hailing cabs from the app.
- ✦ Jammu & Kashmir Bank appointed Parvez Ahmed as Chairman & CEO of the bank. He replaced Mustaq Ahmad.
- ✦ State Bank of India has become the first domestic bank of India to open 54th foreign branch, in the capital city of Yangon, Myanmar. Ghanshyam Srivastava will be the Chief Executive Officer of the SBI Yangon branch.
- ✦ State Bank of India (SBI) declared Silchar as its 5th zone in North-East India. This zone will cater to the banking needs of the people of Mizoram, Tripura and Manipur along with the Barak Valley.
- ✦ RBI's 24th Governor Urjit Patel, who has been recently appointed, has announced his first & country's 4th Bi-monthly Policy Statement for the year 2016-17. The RBI has reduced the policy Repo Rate under the liquidity adjustment facility (LAF) by 25 basis points from 6.5 per cent to 6.25 per cent with immediate effect. Consequently, the reverse repo rate under the LAF stands adjusted to 5.75 per cent, & the marginal standing facility (MSF) rate & the Bank Rate to 6.75 per cent.
- ✦ Arundhati Bhattacharya will remain the chairperson of the State Bank of India (SBI) for another year. She will oversee the merger of 6 smaller commercial banks into the country's largest lender.
- ✦ The Centre has appointed R Subramania Kumar as Executive Director (ED) of Indian Overseas Bank (IOB).

BANKS IN NEWS

- ✦ Public sector major MMTC (Metals and Minerals Trading Corporation of India) has joined hands with HDFC Bank, ICICI Bank and Andhra Bank to retail gold coins with a new buyback option. Besides its own outlets across the country, MMTC has tied up with Indian Overseas Bank, Vijaya Bank, Federal Bank and YES Bank to sell gold coins in denominations of 5 gm and 10 gm coin and 20 gm bar.
- ✦ Bank of America has unveiled a virtual assistant called Erica, that uses artificial intelligence and predictive analytics to learn consumers' personal spending habits and offer financial advice.
- ✦ Banknotes of the denomination of Rs 2,000 will be in circulation soon. The notes have already been printed, and their dispatch from the currency printing press in Mysuru has commenced.
- ✦ NABARD has sanctioned a loan of Rs 19,702 crore to the National Water Development Agency (NWDA), under the Ministry of Water Resources.

ECONOMY NEWS

- ✦ The new law to prohibit benami transactions will come into effect from 1st November 2016. After coming into effect, the existing Benami Transactions (Prohibition) Act, 1988 will be renamed as the Prohibition of Benami Property Transactions, PBPT, Act, 1988. The new legislation provides for seven years imprisonment and fine for those indulging in illegal transactions.
- ✦ The Finance Ministry announced the sixth tranche of sovereign gold bonds. The duration of the bond will be

for a period of eight years with exit option from the fifth year to be exercised on the interest payment dates.

- ✦ The pound saw a sudden collapse in intra-day trade on 08 October 2016, plunging over 6% to \$1.1841 in two minutes, to hit a fresh 31-year-low.
- ✦ The Union Ministry of Urban Development has approved projects worth Rs.114 crore under HRIDAY scheme for improving infrastructure facilities around core heritage sites in five cities. These five cities are: Varanasi (Uttar Pradesh), Amritsar (Punjab), Dwaraka (Gujarat), Puri (Odisha) & Warangal (Telangana).
- ✦ India's foreign exchange reserves scaled a new high of USD 371.99 billion. The reserves had risen by USD 1.166 billion to USD 370.766 billion. Previously, they had touched a high of USD 371.279.
- ✦ The government has integrated 250 mandis in 10 states with the electronic national agriculture market (e-NAM) in the first phase. The target was to integrate 200 mandis by September this year & total 585 by March 2018.
- ✦ International Monetary Fund projects the global growth at 3.1 per cent in 2016, with slight increase to 3.4 percent in 2017. India's gross domestic product is projected to expand 7.6 percent in 2016 and 2017.
- ✦ CCEA approved the acquisition by ONGC Videsh Ltd. of 11% stake in the Russian state-run Vankor oil fields from Rosneft Oil Company for \$930 million, which will take OVL's overall ownership in the project to 26%.
- ✦ The Government has decided to raise the Employees Provident Fund (EPF) investment in Exchange Traded Funds (ETF) from present 5% to 10%.

BUSINESS NEWS

- ✦ Microsoft has launched its first cybersecurity engagement center in India in the heart of Delhi, which will help the government and the private sector organisations to deal with cyber attacks.
- ✦ HCL Technologies has agreed to acquire U.S. based engineering and design services firm Butler America Aerospace, LLC (Butler Aerospace) for cash consideration of \$85 million or Rs.567 crore.
- ✦ Government has formally granted a license to British Petroleum 'Petroleum industry company', headquartered in London, England, Europe's third-biggest oil company, to set up 3,500 petrol pumps in India.
- ✦ Oil & Natural Gas Corp. Ltd (ONGC) beat India's second largest software exporter Infosys Ltd to become the fifth most valuable company in India by market capitalization. TCS is India's most valuable company followed by Reliance Industries Ltd, HDFC Bank Ltd & ITC Ltd.

- ✦ Valvoline Cummins India has signed up India Test captain Virat Kohli as its ambassador. Valvoline is the world's first & most enduring lubricant brand.
- ✦ HCL Technologies has entered into a 15-year partnership deal with IBM for automation, development & operations solutions. HCL will build features & functions on top of existing IBM platforms.

AGREEMENTS/MOU SIGNED

- ✦ India and South Korea have signed a revised Double Taxation Avoidance Agreement (DTAA) for the avoidance of double taxation and the prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to taxes on income.
- ✦ India and New Zealand signed three agreements in the areas of double taxation avoidance, food security and sports.
- ✦ Ministry of Urban Development and the Ministry of Railways signed an MoU under which railway stations and adjoining areas will be redeveloped on smart city lines for enhancing passenger amenities, easy access to stations, enabling optimal utilisation of land at railway stations.
- ✦ During a bilateral meeting attended by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and State Counsellor of Myanmar Aung San Suu Kyi, both sides inked pacts on power, banking and insurance.
- ✦ India & Russia formally inked the agreement for five S-400 Triumf air defence systems & four stealth frigates & a joint venture to manufacture Kamov-226T helicopters in India. The S-400 is considered one of the most advanced long range missile system in the world & can tackle all incoming airborne targets at ranges of up to 400 km.
- ✦ Doordarshan & Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) have entered into an agreement for transmission of four Gyan Darshan educational channels.
- ✦ Cabinet has approved amendments to the HIV & AIDS (Prevention & Control) Bill, 2014 in a meeting chaired by

PM Narendra Modi. The bill makes antiretroviral treatment a legal right of HIV/AIDS patients.

- ✦ The two agreements, one in the field of water resources, including innovations in irrigation technology & second for promotion of co-operation between Indian Council of World Affairs and its Hungarian counterpart was signed between India and Hungary during VP(Ansari) visit.
- ✦ Union Cabinet gave its approval to sign MoU between India & African Asian Rural Development Organization (AARDO) for capacity building programmes in the field of rural development.
- ✦ Union Cabinet gave its approval for the signing of MoU between India & European Union in the field of water resources. The MoU envisages strengthening the technological, scientific & management capabilities of India & the European Union in the field of water management on the basis of equality, reciprocity & mutual benefit.
- ✦ Facebook is collaborating with the Election Commission of India in five states, which are going to polls next year, to run a voter registration drive aimed at encouraging youth to participate in the democratic exercise.
- ✦ India & Singapore have signed 3 agreements, including two in the area of skill development, following delegation-level talks headed by PM Narendra Modi & Singapore Premier Lee Hsien Loong. A third MoU was signed in the field of industrial property cooperation.
- ✦ A historic global climate deal was finalised in Kigali, Rwanda at the 28th Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer (MOP28).
- ✦ The five-nation group of emerging economies BRICS has agreed to set up an independent BRICS Rating Agency in its efforts to challenge the western hegemony in the world of finance.

COMMITTEES

- ✦ BCCI president Anurag Thakur has taken charge as the member of the ICC's powerful Finance & Commercial Affairs committee. Anurag Singh Thakur is a member of Lok Sabha from Hamirpur in Himachal Pradesh.
- ✦ The committee which made the Report on Palaeo Channel of North West India was headed by Prof KS Valdiya, eminent Geologist which suggests that the Saraswati River was not mythical and it existed.
- ✦ BCCI president Anurag Thakur has taken charge as the member of the ICC's powerful Finance and Commercial Affairs committee.
- ✦ The one-man judicial committee on One Rank One Pension submitted its report to the Defence Minister Shri Manohar Parrikar. The Central Government had appointed the committee under the Chairmanship of Justice L Narasimha Reddy.

- ✦ Kristalina Georgieva, a former head of EU humanitarian affairs and vice-president of the European commission, has been appointed chief executive of the World Bank.
- ✦ Bharti Enterprises Founder and Chairman Sunil Mittal has been elected as GSMA (Global System Mobile Association) Chairman for a two- year period from January 2017 through December 2018.
- ✦ Dr. Ajay M. Gondane has been appointed as the next High Commissioner of India to Australia.
- ✦ Mariano Rajoy, Spain's acting prime minister and leader of its center-right Popular Party, was re-elected after winning a parliamentary vote.
- ✦ Swedish telecom gear maker Ericsson has appointed Borje Ekholm as President and CEO.
- ✦ The International Hockey Federation has appointed New Zealand's Jason McCracken as its Chief Executive Officer (CEO).



- ✦ Tata Consultancy Services CEO N Chandrasekaran and Jaguar Land Rover CEO Ralf Speth joined the Tata Sons board as Additional Directors.
- ✦ In one of the biggest upheaval in the corporate sector, the Tata Sons Board has appointed Ratan Tata as the interim chairman of the group, replacing Cyrus Mistry.
- ✦ Jammu and Kashmir Governor N N Vohra has appointed former Chief Justice of Orissa High Court Bilal Nazki as the chairperson of the State Human Rights Commission.
- ✦ Nissan Motor Co Ltd will appoint its chief executive, Carlos Ghosn, as chairman of Mitsubishi Motors Corp.
- ✦ Haryana Government has appointed international woman wrestler Geeta Phogat as a Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) in Haryana Police.
- ✦ S P Yadav has been elected as the new President of the North Zone of Urology Society of India.
- ✦ Morinari Watanabe of Japan was elected as the 9th President of the International Gymnastics Federation (FIG). He will replace Bruno Grandi.


- ✦ Former legislative secretary Sanjay Singh has been appointed as Member Secretary, Law Commission of India.

- ✦ The Mizoram government & the Mizoram Journalists' Association declared Lalbiakthanga Pachuau as the "oldest working journalist in the country".
- ✦ Senior IAS officer Ajay Kumar Bhalla has been appointed as the Director General of Foreign Trade. He has been appointed to the post in place of Anup Wadhawan.
- ✦ Vice Admiral S V Bhokare assumed office as the Commandant of the Indian Naval Academy at Ezhimala in Kerala.
- ✦ India's largest Public sector lender, Bank of Baroda has sealed a principal sponsorship contract with badminton Olympians P V Sindhu & K Srikanth.
- ✦ The government has appointed Reserve Bank's Executive Director G Mahalingam as a Whole-Time Member of markets regulator Sebi.
- ✦ Abdelilah Benkirane, the leader of Morocco's Islamic Justice & Development Party, has been appointed for another term as the country's PM.
- ✦ Former Indian Foreign Service officer Ms. Renu Pall has been appointed as the next Ambassador of India to Austria. It was announced by Ministry of External Affairs.
- ✦ China's President Xi Jinping appointed Luo Zhaohui, a senior diplomat with previous assignments in Pakistan & Canada, as China's new ambassador to India. He will take over from former Chinese ambassador to India Le Yucheng who left New Delhi in April.
- ✦ Germany has appointed former Nasscom Chairman B V R Mohan Reddy as an Honourary Consul of Germany in Hyderabad. Mohan Reddy will be the Consul for Germany in Telangana & Hyderabad.
- ✦ Former PM of Portugal, Antonio Guterres is poised to become the next Secretary-General of the United Nations after the Security Council declared him to be the unanimous choice in the sixth straw poll.
- ✦ Jawhar Sircar has resigned as the Chief Executive Officer of Prasar Bharati Corporation.
- ✦ Reliance Nippon Life Insurance has a new Chief Executive Officer (CEO) in Ashish Vohra.
- ✦ Shri R Ravindra, presently Ambassador of India to the Republic of Cote d'Ivoire, has been concurrently accredited as the Ambassador of India to the Republic of Guinea.

- ✦ Dassault Aviation of France has entered into a partnership with Reliance group to execute offsets for the recently concluded deal for 36 Rafale fighter jets. This is the largest offset contract to be executed by any defence company in India till date.
- ✦ The fast attack craft 'INS Tihayu' was commissioned by India recently. This craft is an improved version of Water Jet Fast Attack Craft (WJFAC).
- ✦ The Indian and Chinese armies began the second joint exercise named Sino India Cooperation 2016 in Ladakh. The aim behind this is to enhance interaction and cooperation between India and China.
- ✦ Russia has quietly signed an agreement with India to lease out a second Russian Akula-2 class nuclear-powered submarine to the Indian Navy.
- ✦ India has completed its nuclear triad by inducting the first endogenously built strategic nuclear submarine INS Arihant into service.
- ✦ Fast patrol vessel ICGS Gaidinliu, named after Naga freedom-fighter and leader Rani Gaidinliu, was commissioned by Director-General Rajendra Singh of the Coast Guard.

- ✚ 47th international film festival of India to be held in Goa in November.


SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

- ✚ Tiangong-2, the experimental space lab of China has successfully launched a micro-satellite, Banxing-2 (the word means Companion Satellite). The micro-satellite is roughly the size of a desktop printer.
- ✚ International Astronautical Federation's renowned space scientist U.R. Rao has been inducted into its Hall of Fame for his contribution to development of India's space technology.
- ✚ China launched the two-man Shenzhou 11 space mission, which is its longest-ever manned space mission. The two astronauts will spend about a month in China's recently-launched experimental space lab, Tiangong 2.
- ✚ India's latest communication satellite GSAT-18 has been successfully launched by a heavy duty rocket of Arianespace from the spaceport of Kourou in French Guiana. GSAT-18, built by the Indian Space Research Organisation, aims at providing telecommunications services for the country by strengthening Isro's current fleet of 14 operational telecommunication satellites.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

- ✚ Bangladesh has arrested more than 900 fishermen and deployed the army to patrol its waterways after introducing a temporary ban on catching hilsa in an effort to save the hugely popular fish.
- ✚ Delegates from 24 countries and the EU have agreed that the Ross Sea in Antarctica will become the world's largest marine protected area (MPA).
- ✚ Typhoon Haima made a landfall in south China's Guangdong Province.
- ✚ The first elephant sanctuary in Latin America has opened in Brazil to provide a home for an estimated 50 circus animals from across the region. Guida & Maia, both over 40 years old, are the first residents.

- ✦ Javelin thrower Annu Rani broke her own national record & in the process became the first Indian woman to cross the 60m mark.
- ✦ Indian star shuttler Saina Nehwal has been appointed as a member of the International Olympic Committee's Athletes' Commission.

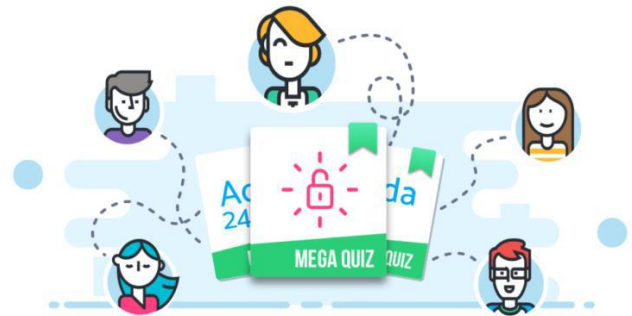
